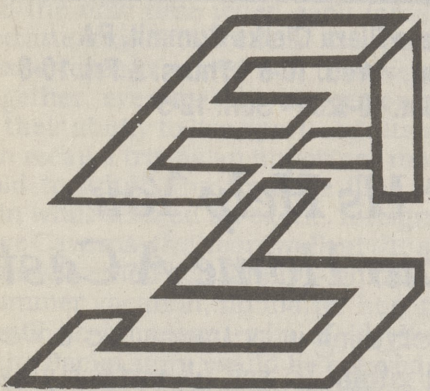
He joined the Navy in June, 1976. Haines is a 1976 graduate of the U.S. Naval Academy, Annapolis, Md. with a BS degree.
