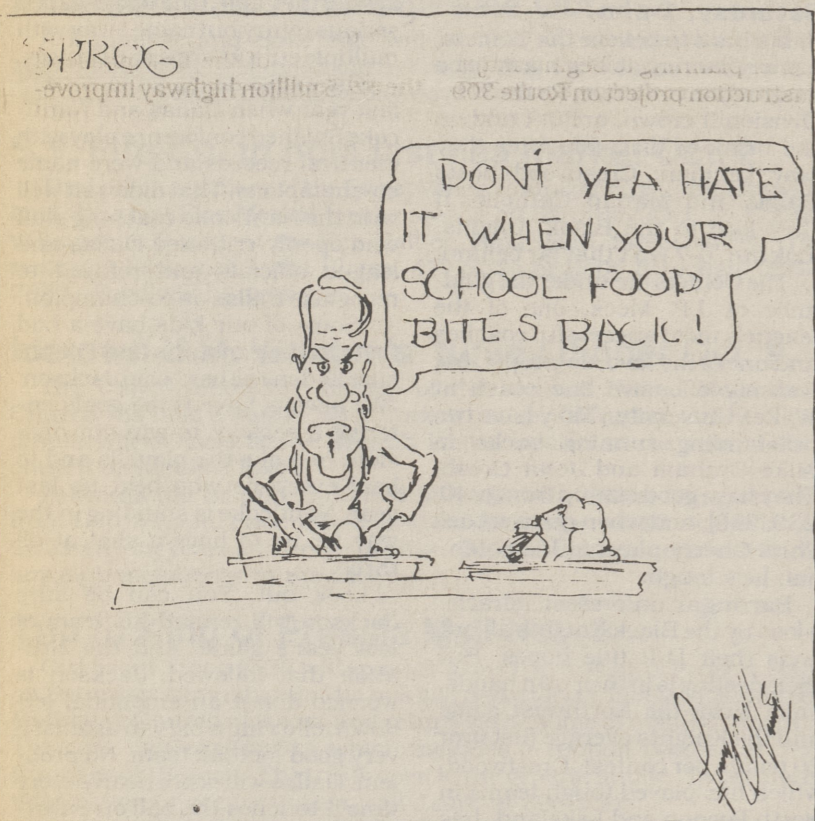
Dallas High School to offer National Merit test Oct. 16

Patricia Russin, Guidance Counselor at Dallas Senior High has announced that juniors will be able to join one million other students around the world in taking the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Tests/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) this fall. The test, co-sponsored by the College Board and National Merit Scholarship Corporation is an important step in making college plans.

Scheduled for Saturday, October 16, at 8:30 a.m. (doors open at 8 a.m.) the test measures verbal and mathematical aptitude, two abilities important in doing college work. The test can also lead to other opportunities for high

school students; they can enter the competition for scholarships administered by the National Merit Scholarship corporation; they can participate in College Board's Student Search Service which is used by hundreds of colleges interested in students like them, also they can get a good idea what the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) is like.

Juniors who are interested in taking PSAT/NMSQT are to register in the guidance office at Dallas Senior High School. The fee for taking the test is \$7.50 payable upon registration. Checks should be made payable to Dallas School District. The deadline for registering for the test is October 13.
