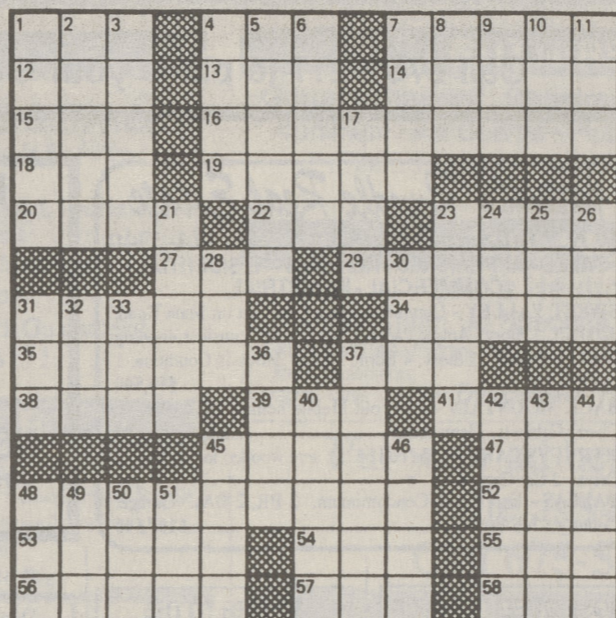
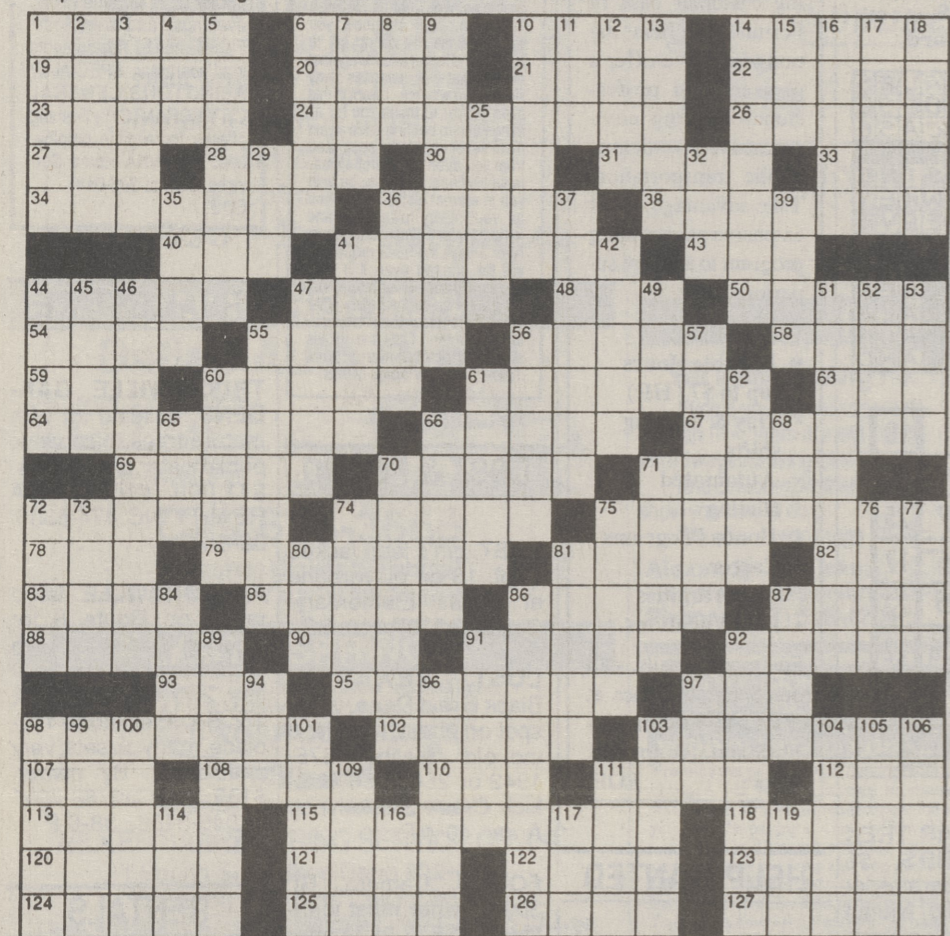

## Hospice St. John promotes Kingston Township woman

Hospice Saint John is a member agency of the UnitedWay of Wyoming Valley and the Greater Hazleton United Way. The agency was founded in 1979 by Lutheran Welfare Service, which also administers programs of nursing care, retirement living, volunteer home care, and counseling and education.
