According to Thomas Reese, adjutant of the Daddow-Isaacs American Legion Post 672, the old plaque needed to be replaced after having developed cracks from exposure to the elements for more than 25 years.

Through the generosity of Chapel Lawn Cemetery, a new bronze plaque will be permanently secured to the back of the monument, Reese said.

"There aren't any names on the Honor Roll," Reese said. "It's dedicated to all veterans of all wars."
