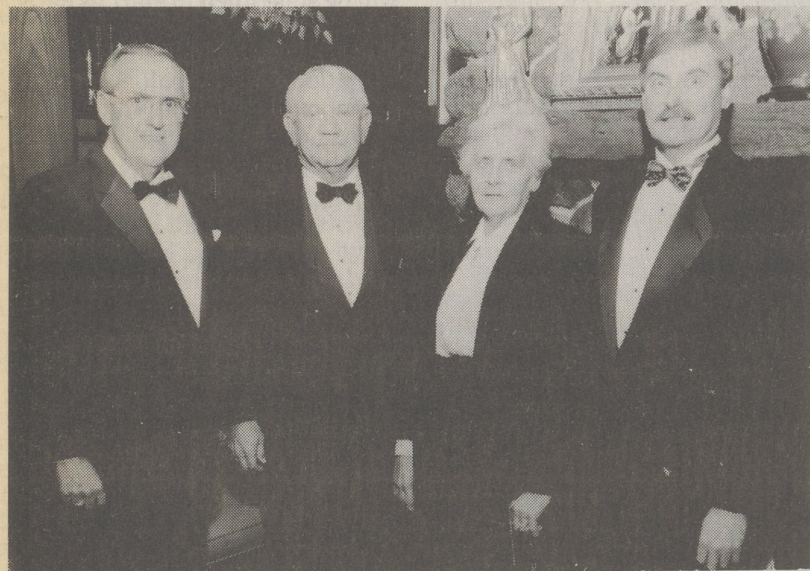




**New board members welcomed**

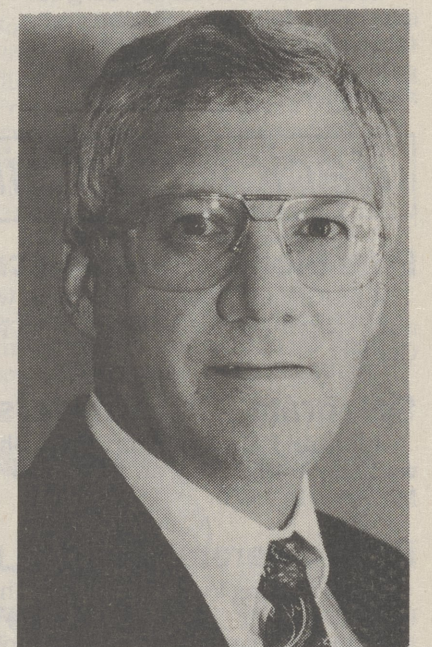
**Penn State honors Hayfield Society members at dinner**
