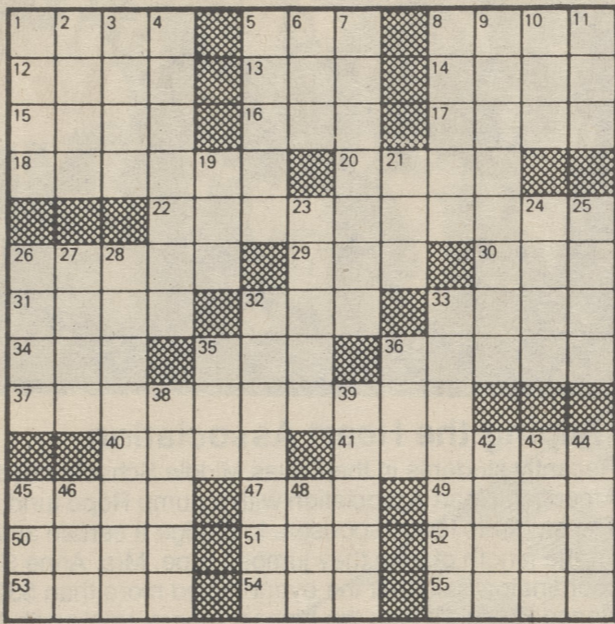
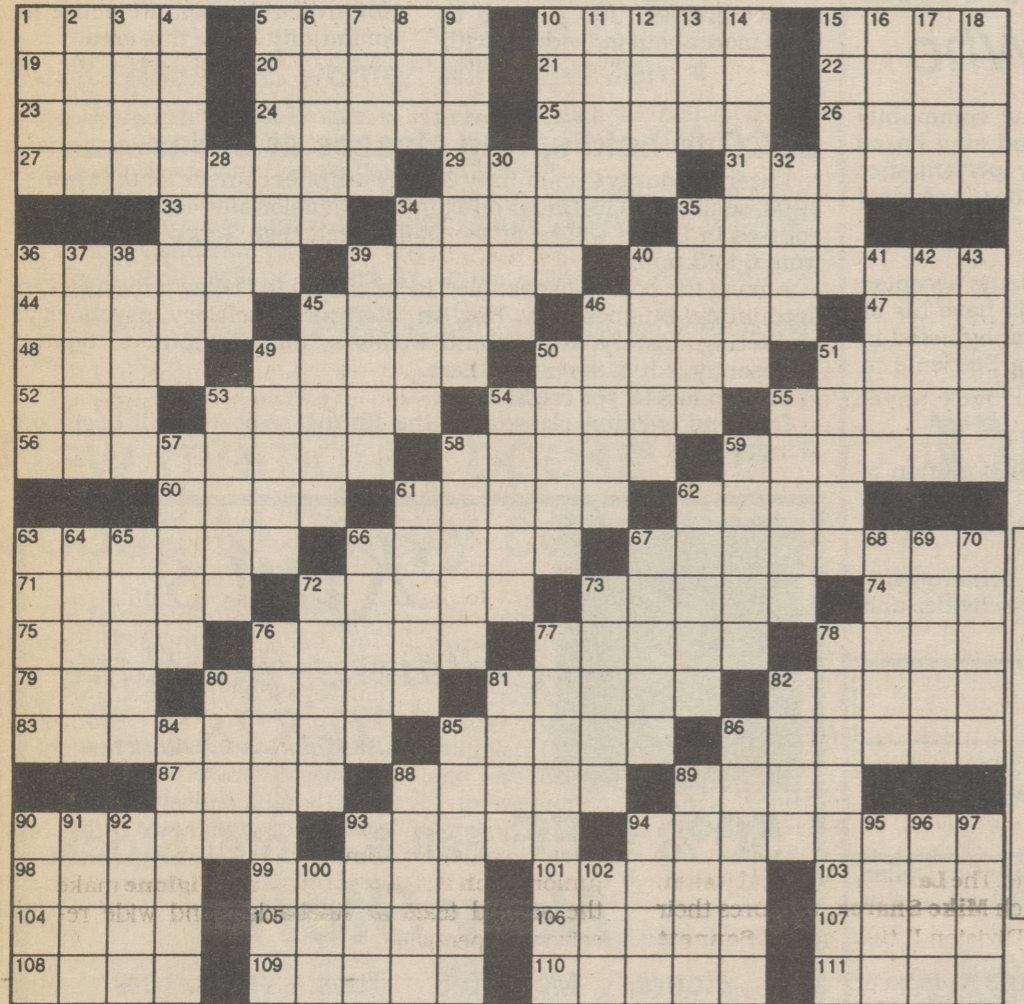

Ag loans can be forgiven

Rep. George C. Hasay said today that applications are available for the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency's (PHEAA) Agriculture Education Loan Forgiveness Program. The program assists students who have borrowed through PHEAA-administered guaranteed student loans programs and receive degrees in agricultural fields or veterinary medicine, provided that they return to operate family farms or practice veterinary medicine that includes large agricultural animals. Applications have been sent directly to 1993 graduates who have remained in Pennsylvania, since they probably will be most likely to benefit.

Those who qualify for the program may receive up to \$2,000 in loan forgiveness. Hasay's office in Sweet Valley next to the post office has applications. The telephone number is 477-3752.
