## Kindergarten registration at Gate of Heaven Jan. 18-20

Registration for Gate of Heaven School's 1994-95 Kindergarten classes will be January 18, 19 and 20 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. in the school lobby on the first floor.

Children entering Kindergarten in September, 1994 must be five years of age before September 30, 1994.

Information needed includes proof of immunizations: three DPT, three oral polio and the following vaccines administered at 12 months or older: measles, mumps and rubella. Parents must present all records of the child's immunizations against childhood diseases in compliance with state standards.

Birth certificate, social security and baptismal records are also required. Non-Catholic stu-

dents need only present birth certificate, social security number and immunization records.

All parents must complete the financial responsibility form and have their pastor sign the parish affiliation form.

A non-refundable registration fee of \$100 must be paid at registration time.

Parents who cannot register within these stated dates, should call the school office, 675-6566 or 675-2121 prior to these scheduled dates to make an appointment to register your child.

Parents may visit the Kindergarten classrooms on Monday and Tuesday, Jan. 31 and Feb. 1, between 9-10:30 a.m. during Catholic School Week.
