


Lions host District Governor

YMCA swim programs will begin February 21

The Wilkes-Barre YMCA is now taking registration for all aquatic programs, set to begin the week of February 21.

Skipper I & II is for infants and toddlers under three years of age, with a responsible adult in the water with the child.

Skipper III is for non-swimmer ages 3 to 5 years old, with a ration of 6 children to one instructor.

Skipper IV is for children ages 4 and5 with swimming abilities. They will learn the proper way to perform the front crawl and the back stroke and have mastered all Skipper III skills in order to be in this level.

Progressive swimming is for children ages six years and over with different swimming abilities.

If parents do not know their child's ability, instructors will test them and place them in the right level.
