# Shavertown man indicted for selling over 100 guns

Shavertown resident Delroy Henson, 40, has been indicted on federal charges of selling firearms without a license, according to a press release issued by the U.S. Attorney General's office.

Between December, 1991, and February, 1994, Henson allegedly sold more than 100 firearms without a license, the press release

He had acquired the firearms in Northeastern Pennsylvania and sold them in Balitmore, Maryland, the release said.

An indictment is a description of the charge against a defendant made by the grand jury and the U.S. attorney and is not evidence of an accused person's guilt.

If Henson is convicted of selling firearms without a license by a jury trial, he faces up to five years in prison and a \$250,000 fine, according to the press release.

The federal Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (ATF) investigated the case, which will be prosecuted by Assistant U.S. Attorney Gordon Zubrod.




