Back Mountain residents will have a chance to learn more about proposals for local tax reform at a community forum next Wednesday sponsored by the Back Mountain Citizens' Council and *The Dallas Post*.

The moderated meeting will offer state legislators and local officials an opportunity to present their views on tax reform, followed by questions from the audience.

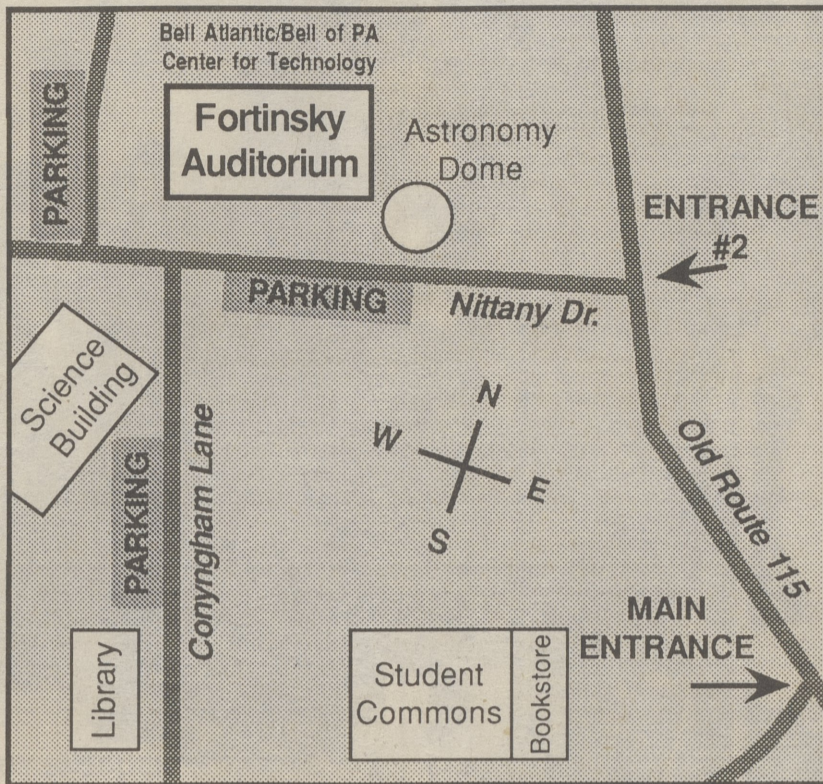
The featured speaker will be David Atkinson, executive assistant to Senate Majority Leader Robert Jubelirer, and an author of a Senate tax reform bill.

The panel also will consist of State Representatives Phyllis Mundy and George Hasay; Walter Glogowski, representing the Pennsylvania Education Association; and Gerald Wycallis, superintendent of the Dallas School District. Charles Watters, executive director of the Central Division Pennsylvania Economy League, will act as moderator.
