Jackson Township seeks grants for work on roads

The supervisors announced at their regular May 2 meeting that the township has applied for a \$10,000 state grant for shoulder and ditch work on Smiths Pond, Pine Tree and Salansky roads, and a \$99,000 federal grant to rebuild Bonkotown Road and finish work on Smiths Pond Road.

An \$8,401 proposal from Software Innovators of King of Prussia for a computer, printer, spreadsheet programs and training for everyone using the computer was accepted.

The supervisors noted that the program will keep a running record of the budget, bills and all expenditures in each budgetary category.

A \$1,500 state grant will help to fund the computer, noted Walter Glogowski, supervisor president.

In other business, the supervisors approved requests from • The Greater Wilkes-Barre Triathlon, to run part of the August 14 race through the township.

• Hospice St. John, to run part of a fundraising 50/100 kilometer noncompetitive bicycle race through the township July 24. This approval is preliminary, pending the approval of the fire and ambulance company.

Hospice St. John will reimburse the township for the use of an extra police officer that day.
