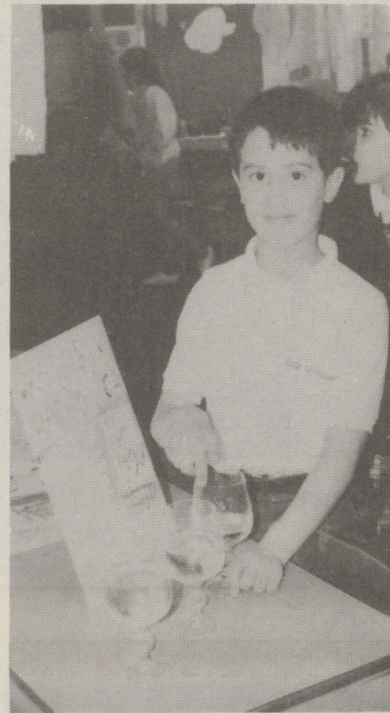


Science fair fun
