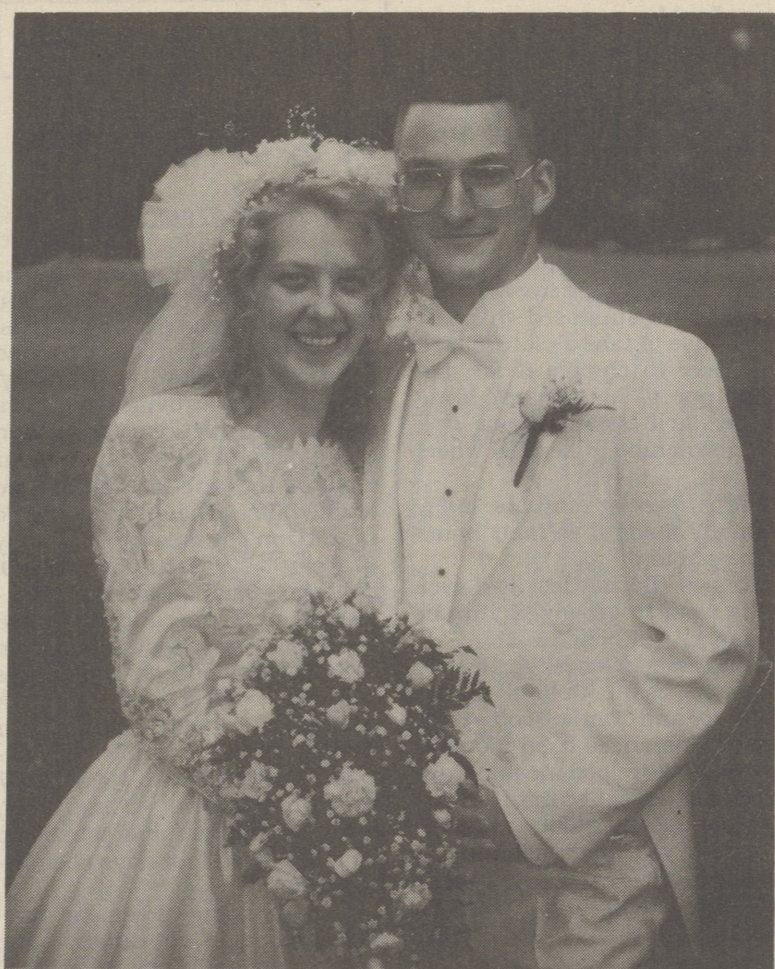

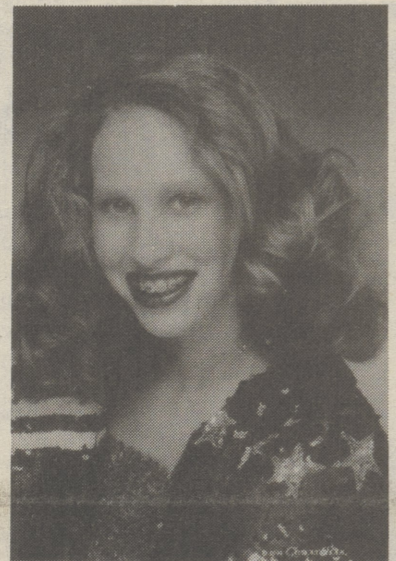
The groom chose Jack Baines as best man. Groomsmen were Mark Fies, brother of the groom, Chad Neidigh and Mark Stallard.

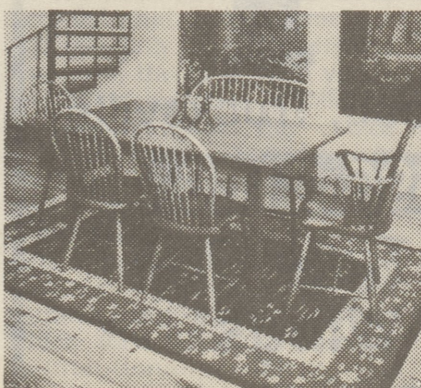
Our continuous arm chair clearly shows the construction of our Windsor chairs and benches.

All legs, arm post, and spindle holes are drilled completely through the seat and arms. Glue is placed in the hole, the legs, posts, and spindles are then secured in the holes. These parts are then split with a chisel and a wooden wedge, with glue driven down into the split to widen the parts in their holes creating a super tight fit.

This 18th century assembly method prevents the chair from becoming loose over years of use.
