## International Council on Education selects Fahmy

Dr. Mahmoud H. Fahmy was recently appointed a member of the board of directors for the International Council on Education for Teaching (ICET).

ICET is a group of teacher educators from all over the world who confer with the purpose to promote the quality of teacher preparation and to deal with educational issues on national and global levels.

Fahmy is a professor of education at Wilkes University and previously served as dean of

graduate affairs and continuing education.

Born in Alexandria, Egypt, he received a bachelor's degree from Alexandria University, master's degree from Columbia University and doctorate from Syracuse University.

He was founder and president of Luzerne/Wyoming Counties Social Studies Council and recipient of its "Best Educator Award."

He also served on the Dallas School Board and the Presiden-

tial Task Force for deregulating public schools in the United States.

Fahmy is the founder of the Youth Forum on Political Awareness in Luzerne County.

An appointed member of the Luzerne County Community College Board of Trustees, Fahmy has served as co-chairman of Luzerne County Bicentennial Commission and is a member of the Advisory Board of Luzerne/Wyoming Counties Mental

Health/Mental Retardation.

Dr. Fahmy is the co-founder of the AIDS Awareness Committee of Luzerne County, is a member of the Board of Economic Development Council of Northeastern Pennsylvania, and the co-founder and member of the Planning Committee of Inter-Religious Encounter Group and a member of the Pennsylvania Center for the Book Advisory Board.

A Dallas resident, Fahmy is married and has three children.

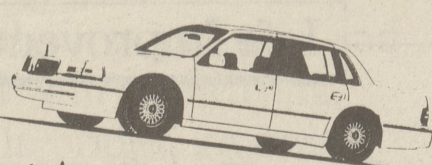

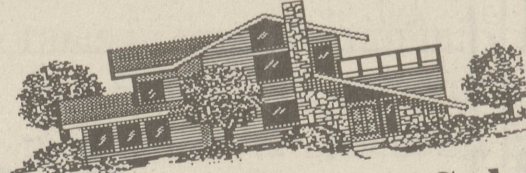
