

PSU welcomes new faculty members

Dr. Thomas Winter, Acting Campus Executive Officer at Penn State Wilkes-Barre Campus, introduced four new full-time faculty members for the 1994-95 academic year at the first campus faculty/staff convocation day recently.

Two new faculty members will occupy one-year replacement positions in physics, the other two are filling tenure track positions in math and English.

Dr. Anatoli Ivanov has been appointed assistant professor of mathematics. He has his B.S. and Ph.D. in mathematics from Kiev State University. He taught at the Ukrainian Academy of Sciences, the University of Munich, Georgia Tech, the University of Minnesota and the University of Rhode Island and is the author of some 40 published papers in the field of mathematics.

In 1988 he received the Soviet "Medal for Young Scientists" for a series of publications on interval maps and their applications.

Dr. David Chin has been appointed assistant professor of English.

He has a B.A. in biology from Antioch College, an M.F.A. in creative writing from Columbia and an M.A. and Ph.D. in English literature from the State University of New York at Binghamton.

Dr. Chin worked 13 years as a biologist before deciding to devote himself to the writing of poetry and the teaching of English literature.

He is the author of a published poetry collection, **Chalked in Orange**, and several of his poems have been published in poetry journals. He will teach creative writing and contemporary literature.

Dr. Ashok Jaie has been appointed a visiting assistant professor of physics for 1994-95 to replace Dr. Steven Alston, who is on sabbatical leave.

He received his B.S. in Physics from Meerut University and his

M.S. in Physics from the University of Roorkee, both in India, and his Ph.D. from the Queen's University of Belfast, Ireland. He has been a research associate, visiting scholar and visiting professor at several universities in India, Europe and the United States.

Cynthia Rheinheimer has been appointed instructor of physics for 1994-95 to replace Dr. Winter while he is acting Campus Executive Officer. Ms. Rheinheimer has a B.S. in Education from Bloomsburg University and an M.S. in Physics from Wilkes University.

She has taught in the Tunkhannock and Pocono Mountain School Districts, and has been an adjunct Penn State faculty member since 1991.

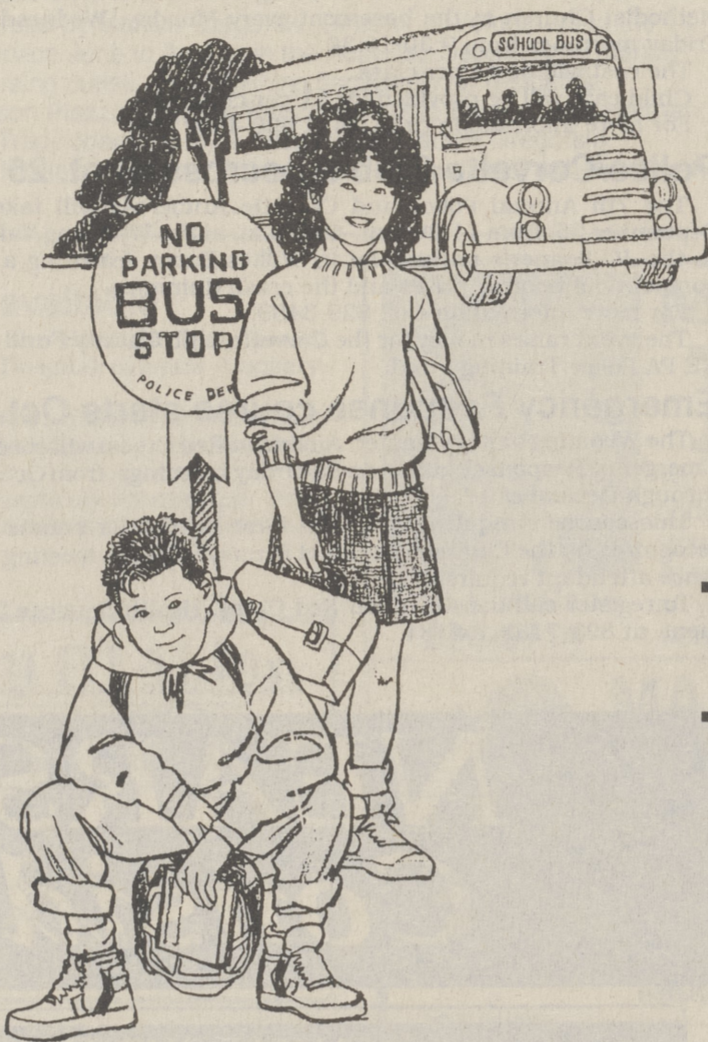
