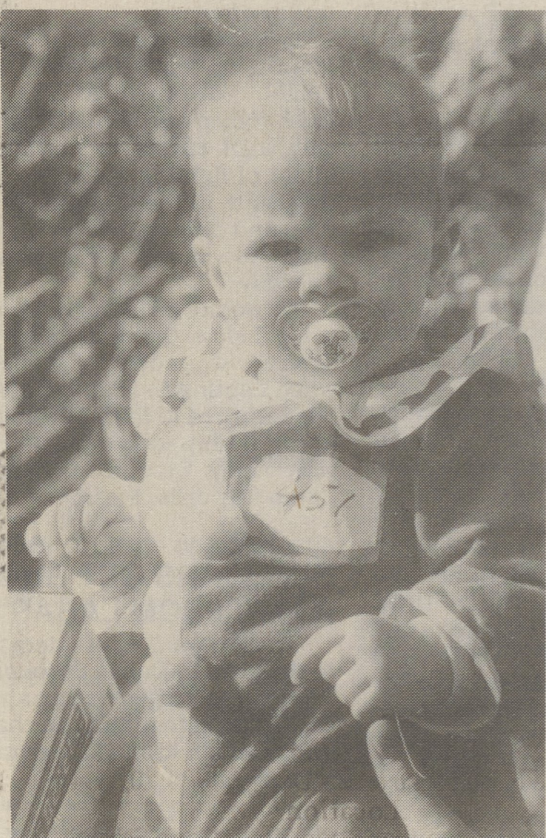

Best Group - Stephen and Matthew Ruch, with mom, Dianne



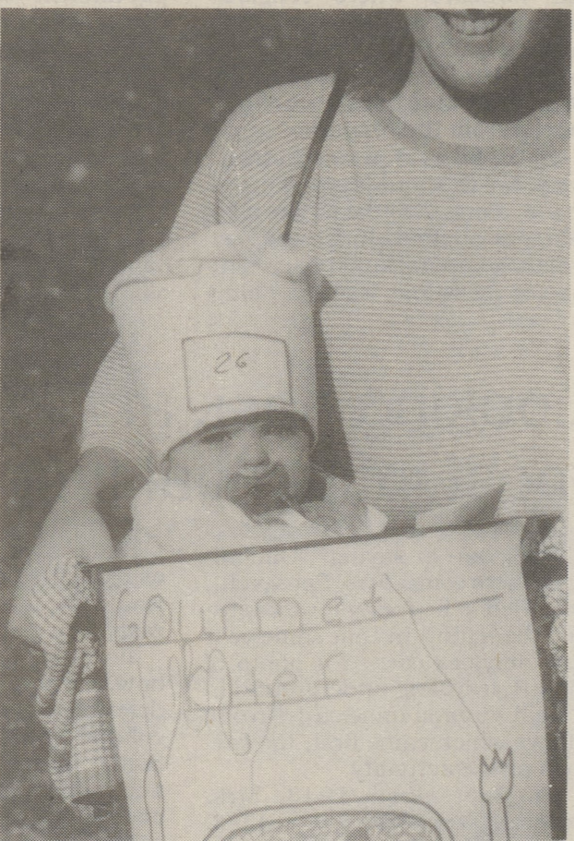

## Republican leader supports Mundy

A staunch Republican official has gone out on a limb by publicly endorsing Democrat Phyllis Mundy for state representative of the 120th district.

Dallas Township supervisor Frank Wagner wrote a letter to the *Times Leader* last week, endorsing Mundy because of her accomplishments which will benefit the Back Mountain.

"She has bent over backwards for us," Wagner said Monday. "She has worked very closely with Representative Hasay and Senator Lemmond to get a grant for our 911 system."

Mundy also attended numerous meetings at Penn State about traffic problems on Routes 309 and 415, which she, Lemmond and Hasay were able to get a federal grant to resolve.

The federally funded multimillion dollar highway improvement project which began this summer will add new traffic lights and improve traffic flow through the Back Mountain within the next two years.

"Phyllis helps people no matter what their party affiliation is," Wagner said. "I came out on a limb for her because I feel I have a winner. I felt I owed it to her because of everything she has done for us."

Republicans outnumber Democrats three to one in Dallas Township, Wagner said.

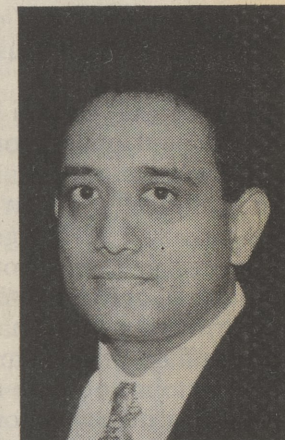

mately 500 feet from Fitch's entrance road.

"The traffic is terrible - trucks and tractor-trailers," Stevenson said. "Sooner or later one of these trucks will hit a child."

"They go more than 55 mph," Moran added.

"Driving that road at 55 is a bit ludicrous," Fitch fired back. "I drive that road myself in my car and would really like to see a truck driver do it at 55."

Fitch must limit the hours of operation and deliveries to Monday through Saturday between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m., the zoning hearing board ruled. The property may no longer be used for commercial purposes after May 1, 1995.

## Property's status is a surprise

When Harveys Lake resident Wayne Evans applied for a zoning variance to build a carport, he didn't know his property has been registered with the borough as a nonconforming zoning use for 16 years.

He bought the irregularly-shaped .875 acre-lot on Lakeview Terrace, zoned residential, in 1968. The house had been built in 1938, he said.

According to codes enforcement officer Paul Grimes, Evans' lot was registered as a nonconforming zoning use because of a problem with 15-foot side yard setbacks and a shed.

"I don't have a shed," Evans fired back. "I'm not violating any setbacks - I'm a good 30 feet from the property line."

Evans said when he applied for a variance for the carport in August, the zoning hearing board didn't understand his intentions. Instead of his sketched plans, they wanted him to submit more detailed plans and rescheduled his hearing.

He knew nothing about the nonconforming use until the October 25 meeting, he said.

Although the zoning hearing board granted Evans a variance, under the condition that the carport is at least five feet from his property line, Evans isn't happy.

He isn't sure how many other properties might be zoned as nonconforming uses without the owners' knowledge.

"I thought I was on trial there," he said. "Do they do that to everyone?"

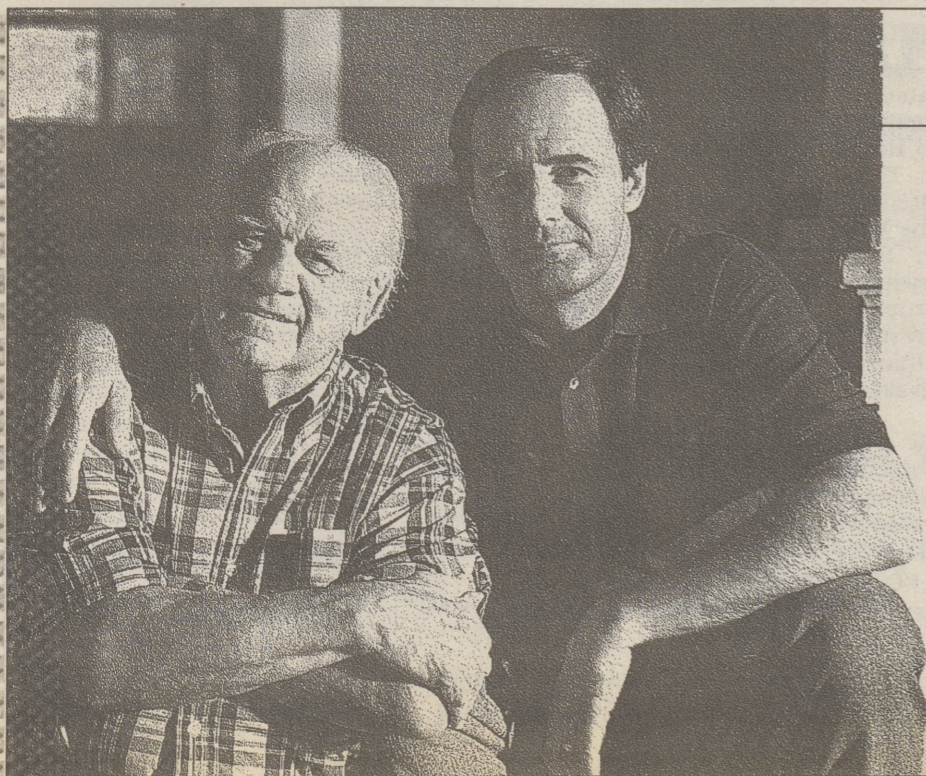
