

In a tough week, Chabala wins Power Points again

The Buffalo Bills dynasty may be coming to an end, but the Chabala family string of local Power Points wins continues.

salary for another year. "It doesn't involve the person," Michael said. "It's the amount. I think Mr. Kvashay should earn more money."

After his \$600 salary was approved, Kvashay told the board he was resigning, "effective immediately."

At that point, the track team walked out of the meeting.

"I couldn't believe that the board let him go so easily," said Jared Rutt after the meeting.

"We're shocked," said Steve Roosa. "We'll do everything possible to keep our program and our coach. We'll train on our own and do the same things we did with coach Kvashay."

"I'm very angry," said Amanda Eisenhart. "The track program could have meant a college scholarship for me - I'll lose it now. Our team is very close, like brothers and sisters."

"He's the best coach I ever had," said Matt Pelak. "The board has misprioritized track and field. They

should have thought it over longer before accepting Coach Kvashay's resignation."

The track team members said they would circulate petitions to keep Kvashay and pay him more among their fellow high school students.

"It's amazing that the board never gave him a raise, while other coaches received regular raises," said track parents Barbara Pelak and Barbara Roberts. "This is a sad commentary on how important football has become to the school at the expense of other sports."
