Lake Township proposed budget available for review

The 1995 budget is based on anticipated revenues from a nine mills real estate tax, a \$5.00 per capita tax, a 1/2% real estate transfer tax, and a 1/2% earned income tax. (These rates have not changed since 1975.)

There is a decrease of about \$6,000 in the total 1995 budget due to the fact that road construction in 1994 has depleted the reserve in the State Aid Fund.

Anticipated spending includes \$9,000 for capital improvements to the buildings, \$17,000 for a new police cruiser, \$1,000 for police uniform allowances, \$700 for a portable radio, \$5,000 for a tractor and mower, \$5,000 for road signs, \$7,500 to aid five fire and ambulance companies, and insurances to cover workers compensation for fire and ambulance personnel.

The following raises (about three percent) for Township personnel have included: Police Chief from \$8.10 to \$8.35 per hour; Patrolman from \$7.70 to \$7.95

per hour; Police Clerk from \$300 to \$310 per month; Road Foreman from \$8.10 to \$8.35 per hour; Laborers in the Road Department from \$7.70 to \$7.95; Secretary from \$650 to \$670 per month; Solicitor from \$150 to \$160 per month.

Based on the 1990 census of 1,924 and a total budget of \$261,700, anticipated spending amounts to about \$136.02 per resident per year. (About \$10 less per resident than in 1994.)

Of the total budget, about 14% is for general government administration; about 26% is for public safety; about 2% is for health services, libraries and cemeteries; about 33% is for highways and about 26% is for insurances, bonding and employee benefits and withholdings.

Nothing has been included for debt service, as our mortgage was paid off in 1992.
