Earn academic honors at Franklin & Marshall

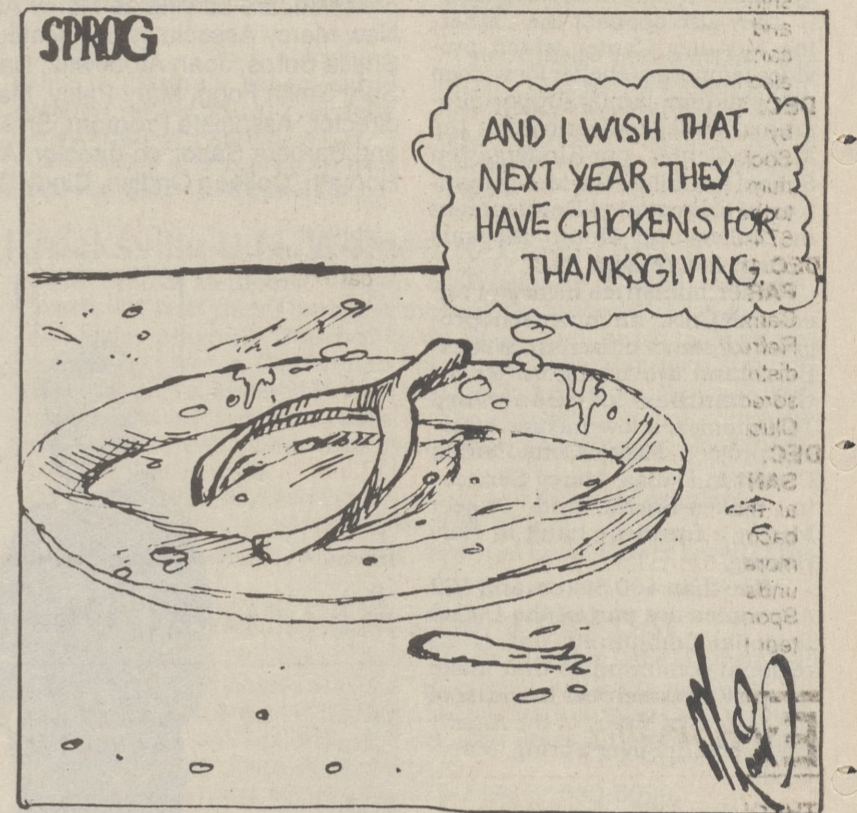
