"The chief also receives extra pay because he does extra work."

The township also expects to spend \$230,000 on demolition of dilapidated structures and paving of two roads, which are reimbursed through the county.

"The county will reimburse us for the Edinger Hill and Campground Hill paving work because the residents' income meets state and federal guidelines," Howell said.

The supervisors will approve the final budget at their December 20 meeting.
