## Mellon Bank will display Charles Woodworth's art

Many of the artworks on display feature his plein air art work, including a scene of sheep near a pond, a stark winter tree completed outdoors on location in six-degree weather and a pastel sunset over Wyoming Valley created while he sat on the roof of his car during his dinner break from work.

His artwork was chosen to appear in the 1995 edition of the WRGN "Scripture Verse" calendar and an interview with the artist appeared this past summer in "Air Currents," the newsletter of the Pennsylvania En Plein Air Society, of which Woodworth is a signature member.

Woodworth is the assistant manager of Design Galleries at the Wyoming Valley Mall. He serves on the board of the Cider Painters of America.
