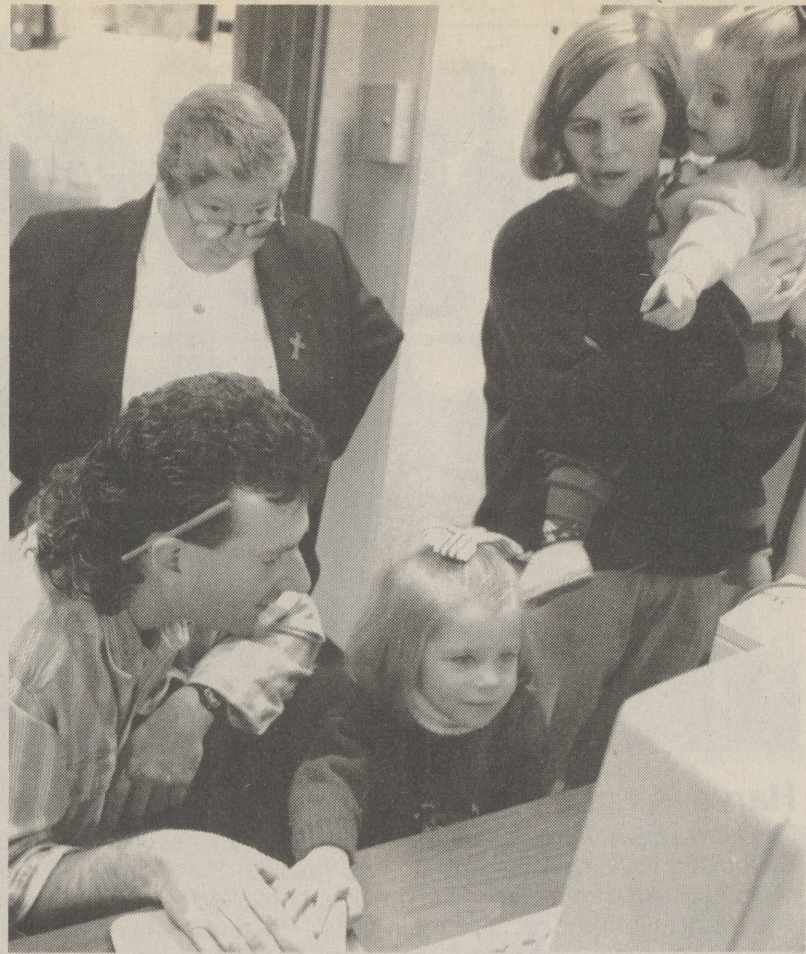

LCCC to hold registrations at Dallas Jan. 4

Luzerne County Community College will offer a full slate of courses for the Spring 1995 semester at its Dallas off-campus extension site. Registration will be at the Dallas Area High School, January 4, from 6 to 8 p.m.

Among the courses scheduled to be offered are accounting, business law, English, literature, sociology, psychology, marketing, history, fitness/wellness, microcomputers, education, CPR and algebra.

Tuition is \$48 per credit hour, enabling students to complete a one-year certificate program at a cost of slightly more than \$1,500 and a two-year degree program at a cost close to \$3,000.

Day and evening classes for the Spring semester will begin on Monday, January 23.

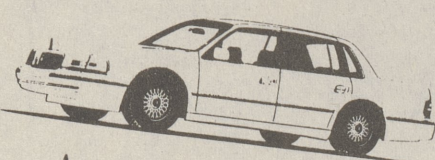

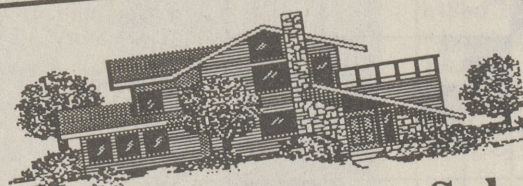

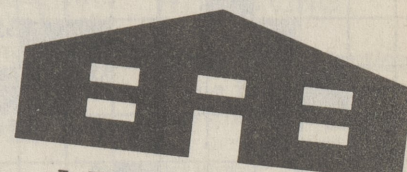
