As the deadline approached, no one had been able to produce the necessary fish samples until Mayor Rick Boice, ace angler, came to the rescue.

Boice had hooked the 19-inch

lunker in mid-September and popped it into his freezer to preserve for mounting.

"When David Abod told me he needed a fish, I figured I'd catch another one at least this size, so I gave it to him," Boice chuckled. "It was in perfect shape. When you freeze a fish for mounting, you don't gut or clean it - it must be intact. And this one filled the bill."

"It's in great shape," noted council president Ed Kelly, who commended Boice for sharing his finny treasure at the January 17 council meeting. "It's perfect. Now all we need is an alewife, and the guys are out there right now trying to get one."
