

The Crucible at Seminary

Arthur Miller's drama "The Crucible" will be presented by the Wyoming Seminary Players February 10 and 11, at 8 p.m. in the Buckingham Performing Arts Center, North Sprague Avenue, Kingston.

Directed by Seminary faculty member W. Carver Collins, "The Crucible" tells the familiar story of the 17th-century Salem witchcraft trials.

Arthur Miller wrote "The Crucible" during the McCarthy "witch hunts" of the early 1950s, when many of his friends and colleagues found themselves in much the same situation as the Salem townspeople.

Dallas and Lake-Lehman schedule guidance tests

The Dallas and Lake-Lehman school districts will administer assessments (standardized tests) in reading and math skills between February 13 and March 3 to students in grades 5, 8 and 11.

The results will not affect students' grades in any way. The districts will use the assessment test results to improve the curriculum.

Individual students results will be distributed to parents, teachers, guidance counselors and/or principals. The state will not receive copies of individual results containing students' names.
