Students gain from first OBE projects

Since Lake-Lehman School District is a phase one district, it must begin to prepare for the new Chapter 5 regulations. Under the new regulations, the freshman class entering Lehman in September, 1995 will be the first class required to complete 53 students' learning outcomes and complete a graduation project.

To make sure that the organization of the graduation project will be operational, it is necessary to pilot the project.

In January of this year, several students volunteered to take part in the program. Two Advanced Placement Chemistry students, Shannon Kelly and Chris Pagoda, perform science experiments once a week for 5th graders in the Lehman-Jackson Elementary School. Playing the role of Mr. Wizard, Shannon and Chris cover


science projects that involve dissecting frogs, coating pennies with zinc to make them look like gold, and creating chemical gardens which contain home-made crystals. By performing such experiments, the children see a brighter side of science.

Advanced Placement Spanish students Jennifer Feehan, Sonya Sabaluski, Melissa O'Donnell and Kim Frederick and four IndependSichler, Beth Kelly, Cara Nygren, and Tiffany Roese, share their knowledge of language with fourth graders two times a week at the Lehman-Jackson Elementary School. To teach kids the basics of the foreign language, the girls use creative props. For example, a fruit salad was used to help the kids learn the fruits names and the game Simon Says was played to introduce the kids to body parts. These various exercises give the

children an opportunity to possibly see which language they would like to take in high school.

For their participation in this program, students receive an extra grade which is averaged into their other academic studies. Before receiving an extra grade, volunteers must fulfill all of the project's criteria. The essential criteria consists of a journal showing everything they have accomplished. a video which presents the individual student teaching, and a senior presentation. Students are also required to meet with facilitator Mrs. Jeris Baranowski, every two weeks to analyze and evaluate the progress.


