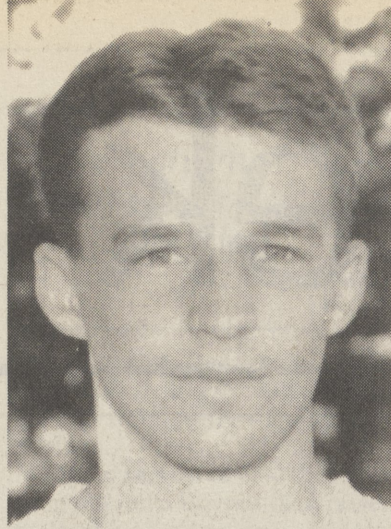

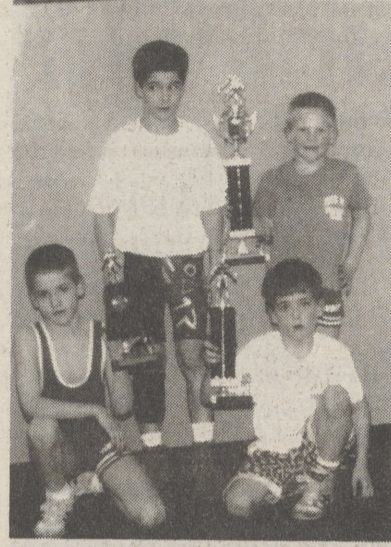
### RED SOX 7 - WHITE SOX 1
