Lake-Lehman Prom Queen, court, committee

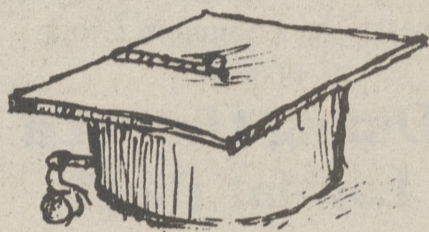
Lake-Lehman High School recently held its Junior-Senior Prom at the Woodlands Inn and Resort. The theme of the event was "All I Want Is You".
