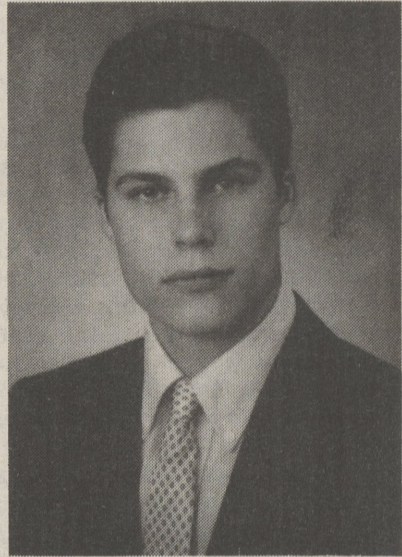
Toluba to attend Bucknell U

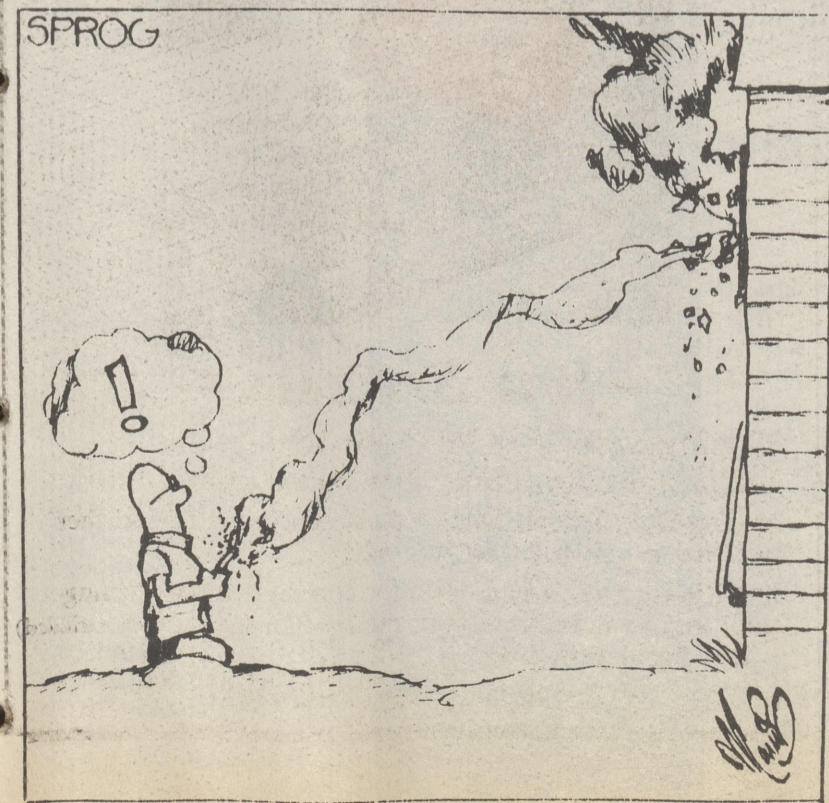
