


Brian Downey stabbed a hot shot down the line.



Eric Kowalek of the Dodgers slid into third under the tag of the Reds' Danny Lorenzi.




Oriole hurler Ryan Gryskevicz celebrated his team's 1-0 win over the Reds




Josh Katyl fired to first and nailed a North End batter in the National League All-Stars' win July 1.
