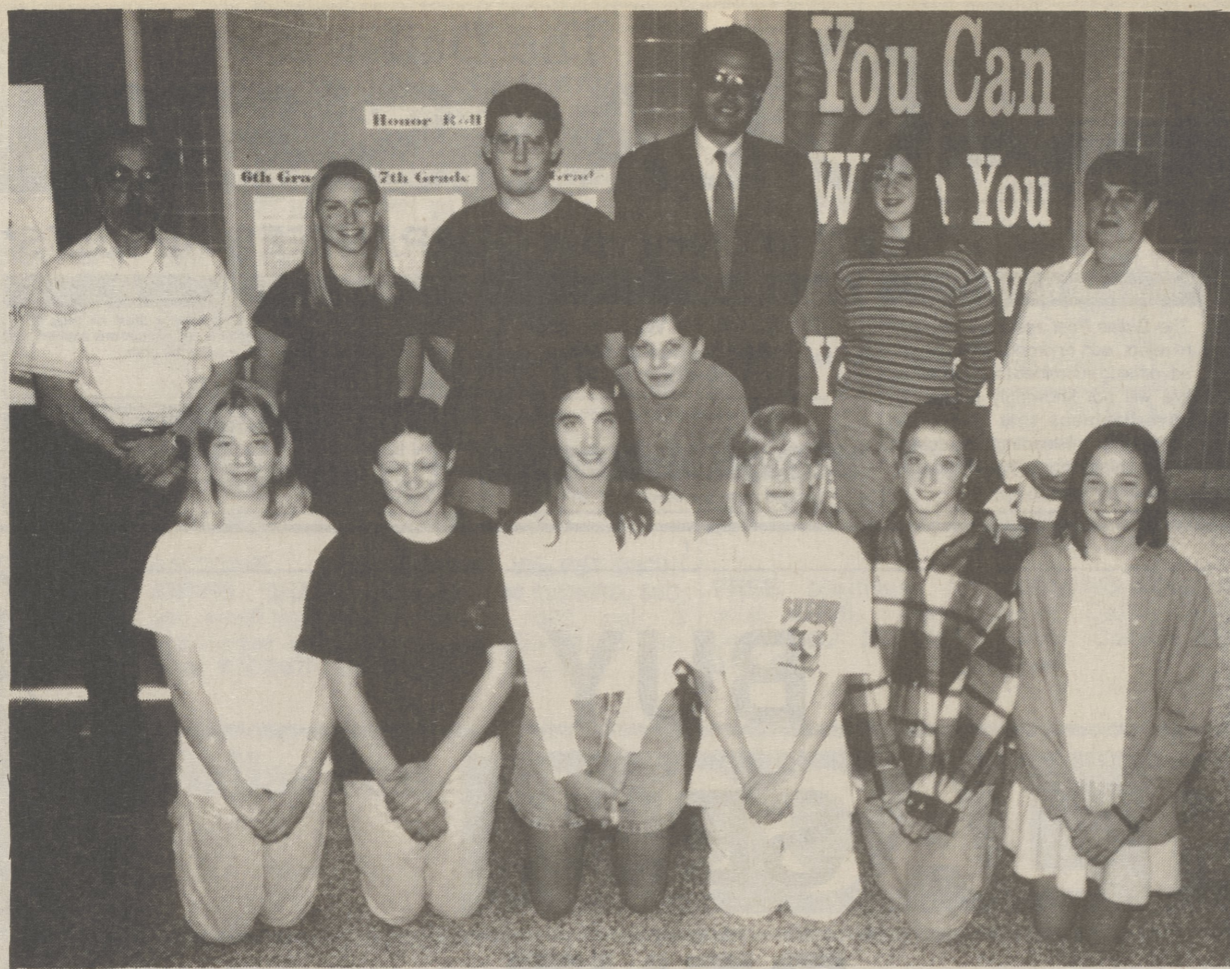
## Cleary named to Wake Forest Dean's List

Trucksville Nursery School, located in the educational building of the Trucksville United Methodist Church, has openings in its 3 year old and 4 year old programs.

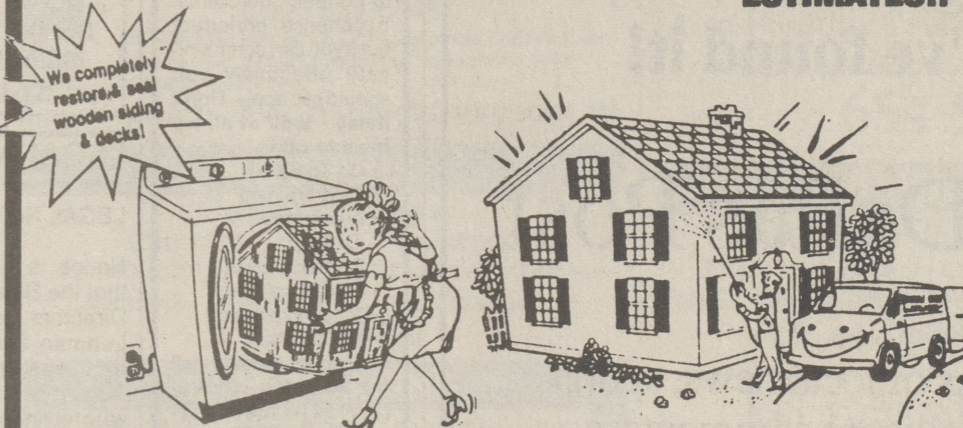
