

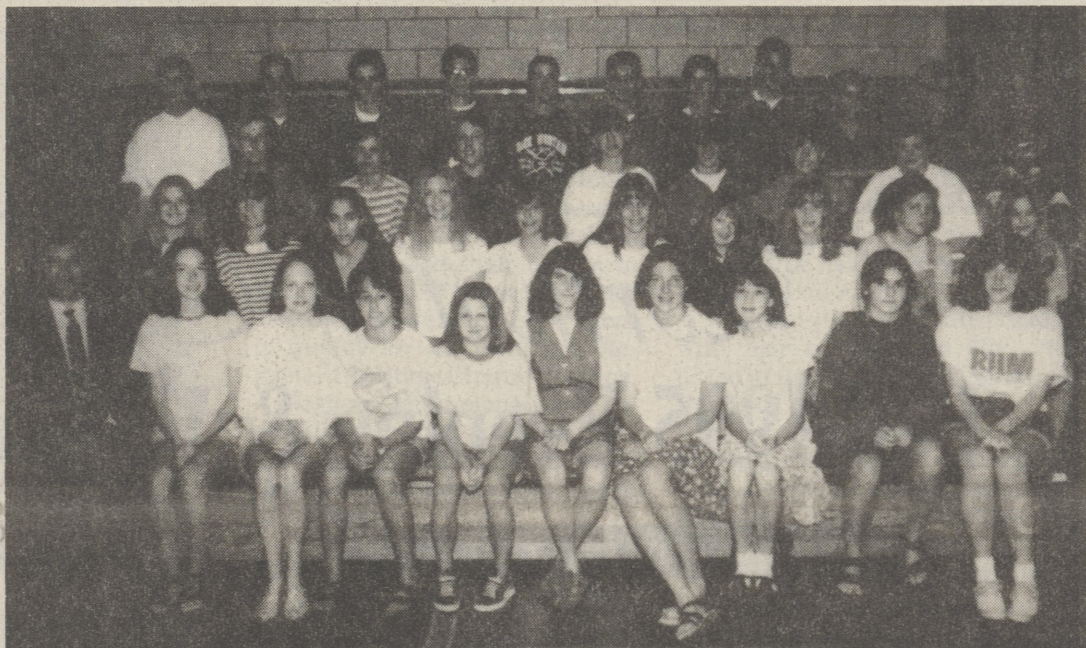
Tops in their subject areas

Brothers earn Masonic scholarships

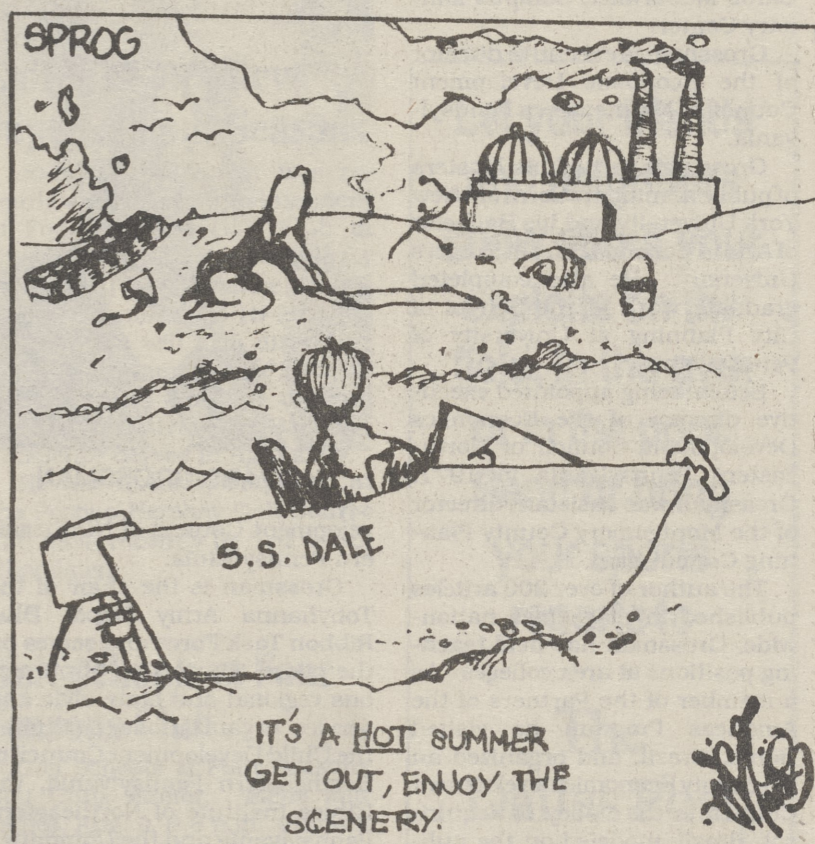
The Scottish Rite Masons headquartered at Bloomsburg have announced the award of Abbott Scholarships to brothers James and Jason Reynolds of Trucksville.
