

Opening day information for Dallas Elementary

Room assignments will be given first day

For kindergarten to fifth grade students who attend the Dallas Elementary School, school will begin August 30. The staff will be preparing the building and participating in activities prior to the opening of school to make the start of the school year as smooth as possible.

First to fifth grade students will attend full day sessions from 9:10 a.m. to 3:40 p.m. Parents should consult the bus routes published in the newspapers to determine their child's bus assignment and departure points. It is requested that students ride a bus to and from school the first day to facilitate student awareness of their bus assignment and to aid the school district in maintaining accurate and comprehensive student transportation records. If it is necessary for a parent to accompany a child to school, it is suggested that the student ride the bus and the parent meet the student at the school building.

Regular student lunches will be available the first day. Elementary lunches are \$1.30, reduced lunches are 40 cents and milk is 40 cents. Students may bring their entire lunch or may purchase their beverage. Snacks are available.

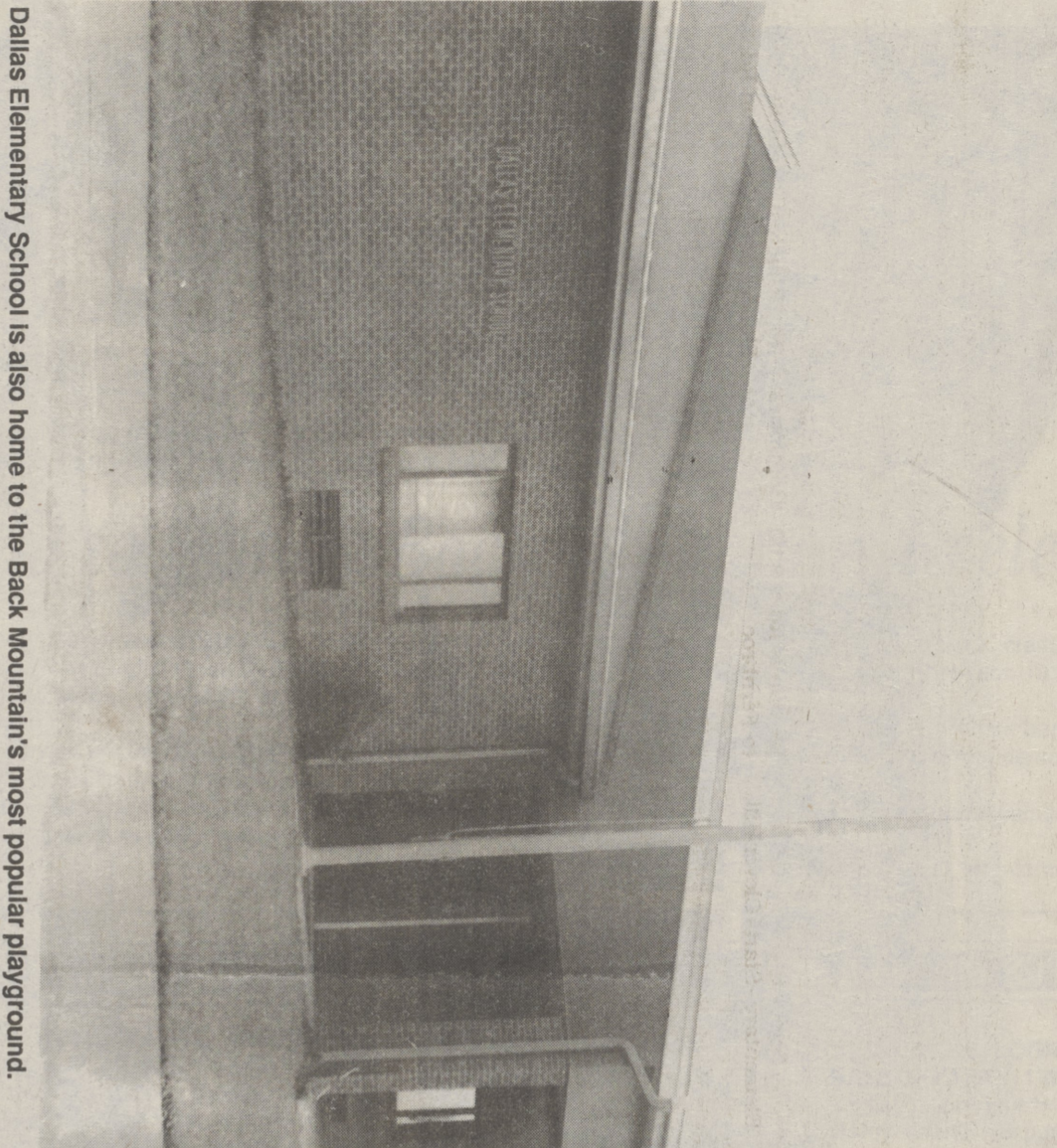
Kindergarten students will attend pre-arranged sessions August 30 and 31. On Friday, Sept. 1 morning students will take buses to school and be dismissed at 10:30. Afternoon students will be picked up for a 2:15 arrival at school and be dismissed with other students at the end of the day. On Tuesday, Sept. 5, they will attend regularly scheduled kindergarten sessions.

To facilitate student room assignments the first day, the following plans have been developed.

All fifth grade students will report to Mrs. Crabtree's room (#306), All fourth grade students will report to Mrs. Reilly's room (#108). Third grade students will report to Mr. Wesley's room (#204). Second grade students will report to the cafeteria and first grade students to the gym. Teacher and parent volunteers will be available to aid students.

To ensure greater security of student lockers, combination padlocks will be available to rent for a \$2.00 refundable fee. Students should bring \$2.00 to school the first day. Locks will be available from the homeroom teachers. Personal locks are not permitted.

Students will be able to purchase lunch beginning with the first day of school for \$1.40.

Preparations for the opening of the Dallas Middle School have been underway. Principal Anthony B. Martineil, and his staff have been busy all summer readying the building and program for the opening of classes August 30.

The school's master schedule has been constructed to provide each student with a well-rounded program of subjects supplemented with numerous co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

Sixth, seventh and eighth grade students will report to the middle school between 7:45 and 8 a.m. Sixth-graders will report to the auditorium. Seventh-graders will report to the gymnasium. Eighth-graders will report to the cafeteria for a short orientation program and assignment to homerooms. Students will then report to their homerooms.

Route #19 - 7:10 - Start at Strull. Pick up all elementary students to Market Street, Noxen Road, 29 assigned students to Lakeside Dr. Pick up students on Queen of Peace Road, Chestnut Tree, Tulip Road, School House Road to Lake-Noxen Elementary.
PM - Reversed.
Route #20 - 7:00 - Start at Intersection of Route 415 & Pine St. Halowich Road, Tulip Tree Road, Sorber Mountain, Swan Road, Moorstown Road, Evergreen Estates. Exchange elementary and secondary students with **Route #21**. Routes 29 & 118 to High School, Elementary, Junior High.
PM - Reversed.
Route #21 - 7:00 - Start at Intersection of Route 415 & 295 at Township Line. North Mountain Road, Sunny Acres Road, Chisman Road, Moorstown Road, Evergreen Estates. Exchange secondary and elementary students with **Route #20**. Use Maple Tree Road, Outlet Road, Loyallville Road, Tulip Tree Road, Halowich Road. Left at "r" on Pine St. Lakeside Drive to Lake Noxen Elementary.
PM - Reversed.
Route #22 - 7:10 - Start at Route 118 & Trojan Road. Right onto 1581 to Route 295. Turn around at Catholic Church. Route 29 to Lakeside Dr., Cease Terrace. Return to Route 29N, Lakewood Dr., and Route 29 as signed students.
PM - Same.
Route #22.1 - 7:05 - Start on Logansville Road, Gordon Road, Maple Tree Road, Hickory Tree Road, Pine Tree Road, Loyallville Road to Cornell Road. Turn around at Pikes Creek Store, Lehman Mecker Road to Junior High, High School and Elementary.
PM - Reversed.
Route #22.2 - 6:55 - Run #1. LEHMANCENTER students. Start on Main Road Sweet Valley at Pall Road, Hahn Road (1540), Cedar Road (SR 4025), Right turn at Post Office. Use Grassy Pond Road to Main Road Sweet Valley. At Township Building use T-684 to Main Road Sweet Valley. Proceed to Lehman Center and discharge students at schools.
Run #2. Return for ROSS ELEMENTARY students repeating route and include North Lake. 3:25 - Receive LEHMANCENTER STUDENTS. Discharge enroute to Ross Elementary via Pall Road, Hahn Road, Pritchard Corners, receive ROSS STUDENTS. Use Grassy Pond Road to T-571. Go to Calendar Road, Hahn Road, Pall Road.
Route #23 - 7:05 - Run #1. LEHMANCENTER students. Start on Bronson Road, Moorstown Road, Route 118 to TR 644 and turn around. Route 118, Garbush Hill/Grassy Pond Road. Use T-571 to Main Road Sweet Valley. Route 118E and Lehman Center. Discharge students at schools.

Run #2. Return for ROSS ELEMENTARY students. Use Bronson Road, Moorstown Road to Route 118W. Pick up students from R & R Store to TR 644. Turn around and return to Grassy Pond/Garbush Hill Road. Discharge at Ross School. 3:25 - Receive LEHMAN CENTER students at High School, Route 118W to Grassy Pond/Garbush Hill Road. Discharge students enroute. Receive elementary students at ROSS SCHOOL. Return over Grassy Pond Road. Route 118W to TR 644. Return to Moorstown Road. Use Bronson Road to Route 118.
Route #24 - 7:00 - Run #1. LEHMANCENTER students. Start Keller Road by Bronson Road. Route 118 to R & R Store and turn around. Route 118 to Harris Pond Road, Main Road, Sweet Valley. Pick up assigned students along Main Road Sweet Valley to Lehman Center. Discharge students.
Run #2. Return for ROSS ELEMENTARY students. Start on Keller Road. Route 118W to R & R Store. Turn around and return to Harris Pond Road. Pick up assigned students on Main Road Sweet Valley to Ross Elementary School. 3:25 - Receive LEHMAN CENTER students at High School. Use Route 118W and Main Road Sweet Valley and discharge students. Receive ROSS ELEMENTARY students at school. Return over

students.
Run #2. Return for ROSS ELEMENTARY students repeating route.
Route #25 - 6:50 - Run #1. LEHMANCENTER students. Start at "r" of Cannonball & Bear Swamp (1569). To Broadway Road. Turn around at Hoyt's on SR 4021. Ledger Hill to Mulhemburg/Sweet Valley Road, Sylvan Lake. Go to Pritchard Corners. Turn around. Proceed to Cemetery Road via Main Road Sweet Valley, left on Route 29 proceeded to High School.
Run #2. Return for ROSS ELEMENTARY students in Broadway area repeating route.
2:45 - Pick up SWEET VALLEY ACADEMY students for public routes at High School.
3:25 - Receive LEHMAN CENTER students. Discharge students on Main Road Sweet Valley enroute to ROSS ELEMENTARY. Receive students. Discharge to Sylvan Lake. Use 1658 & Ledger Hill to Broadway area.
Route #26 - 6:40 - Run #1. LEHMANCENTER students. Start on Nevel Hollow Road. Go to Bloomingdale Corners. Turn around at Orange Hall. Pick up students on SR 4019, 1513, SR 4016, Sr 4023. Go to Traylor Court/Peat Moss Road, Sweet Valley/Broadway Road. Proceed to Lehman Center picking up assigned students along Main Road Sweet Valley. Discharge

students.
Run #2. Return for ROSS ELEMENTARY students repeating route.
Route #27 - 7:20 - Start on Main Road Sweet Valley. Pick up assigned students along road and at North Lake. At High School receive SWEET VALLEY CHRISTIAN and MULHEMBURG CHRISTIAN students brought in by public routes. Route 118 to Sweet Valley picking up students enroute. Discharge Sweet Valley Christian Academy students. Go to Sweet Valley/Broadway Road. Left turn past Moss's onto 1654. Proceed to Mulhemburg Christian Academy via Bloomingdale.
2:45 - Receive SWEET VALLEY CHRISTIAN students for Route 118.
3:30 - Return MULHEMBURG CHRISTIAN students.
Route #27.1 - 3:25 - Receive LEHMAN CENTER students for Main Road Sweet Valley and North Lake. Pick up ROSS ELEMENTARY students for Main Road Sweet Valley and North Lake.
