See the stars in Penn State astronomy workshop

Penn State Wilkes-Barre's popular astronomy workshop will be offered again this fall beginning September 20. The noncredit course will run four weeks on alternate Wednesdays, from 7 to 9 p.m., and will utilize the 14inch Celestron telescope in the Friedman Observatory on the campus in Lehman.
