### School bus in accident

A school bus operated by Angelo Concert, 55, Harveys Lake, collided with a 1986 VW Rabbit driven by Danielle Parise, 23, Harveys Lake at about 3 p.m. Sept. 8 at the intersection of Route 309 and Main Road. Police said witnesses reported that Concert failed to yield to the southbound car, which struck the right rear of the bus. There were 24 Dallas students age 14 to 17 on the bus. No injuries were reported. The students were transferred to another bus after the accident. The car was towed and the bus was driven from the scene. Dallas Township officer Jeffrey Dennis is investigating. No charges have yet been filed.

### Police bringing two from South

Dallas Township police are in the process of extraditing two alleged criminals, one from Florida and another from Georgia.

Chief Carl Miers said two officers will travel to Florida to take custody of Ernest William Chapman, 41, of Main Rd., Dallas who is charged by Dallas Township police with rape, statutory sexual assault, involuntary deviate sexual intercourse, indecent sexual assault, aggravated indecent assault and corruption of minors. The charges stem from an incident June 8 in which Chapman allegedly raped a 13-year-old girl at his home.

Chapman faces similar charges in Hanover Township. A Hanover Township patrolman will accompany the Dallas Township officers to Florida to take custody of Chapman.

Officers will also bring back Matthew Bullock, 18, 370 W. Overbrook Rd., back from Pelham, Georgia, where he was apprehended. Police say he will be charged with burglary and theft in connection with an incident Sept. 4, in which he allegedly broke into a residence at 364 W. Overbrook and stole jewelry and other items from the home.

Police say he also stole a 1993 Corvette from the home.

Miers said he hopes to have both men back in Dallas for arraignment Thursday evening.

### DISTRICT COURT BRIEFS

#### DUI CHARGE WAIVED TO COUNTY COURT

April-Jo Allen, RR 1, Hunlock Creek, waived her right to a hearing on DUI charges during a hearing before District Magistrate James Tupper Sept. 7. The charge stemmed from an incident July 6 when Allen was pulled over by Dallas Borough Officer James Martin when he observed a car traveling slowly and weaving across lanes on Route 415. When Martin said the erratic driving was the reason he pulled Allen over, she replied "I always drive like that, on top of the yellow lines." Martin found two empty beer bottles in the car. After failing field sobriety tests, Allen was taken to the county DUI processing center where her blood alcohol level was measured at .139, above the legal limit of .10. Dallas Twp.

### Jackson Twp. August building permits

Seven permits were issued in Jackson Township during August. The largest was for \$443,000, for roofing work on five buildings at the Chase prison.

### Kingston Twp. issues 44 building permits

The Kingston Township Zoning Office granted 44 permits during the month of August, and collected \$2,395 in fees.

Among the permits were a new home at 15 Maple Leaf Drive, valued at \$127,600; a new home at 57 Perrin Ave., valued at \$95,400; and two mobile homes on Harris Hill Road, valued at 32,000 and 39,000.



### Legion notes V-J Day

Members of the Daddow-Isaacs Post 672 of the American Legion gathered Sept. 9 to note the 50th anniversary of V-J Day, when Japan officially surrendered, ending World War II. After breakfast and a speech from State Sen. Charles Lemmond, the members assembled to lay a wreath in front of the Legion Post.
