

The first library building was the vacant Ryman home on Main Street in Dallas Borough. It was purchased and set up for about \$10,000.



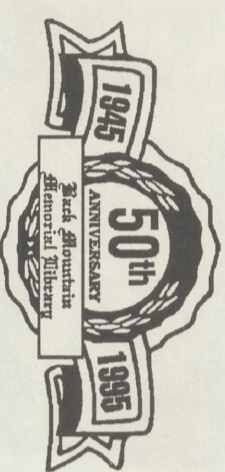

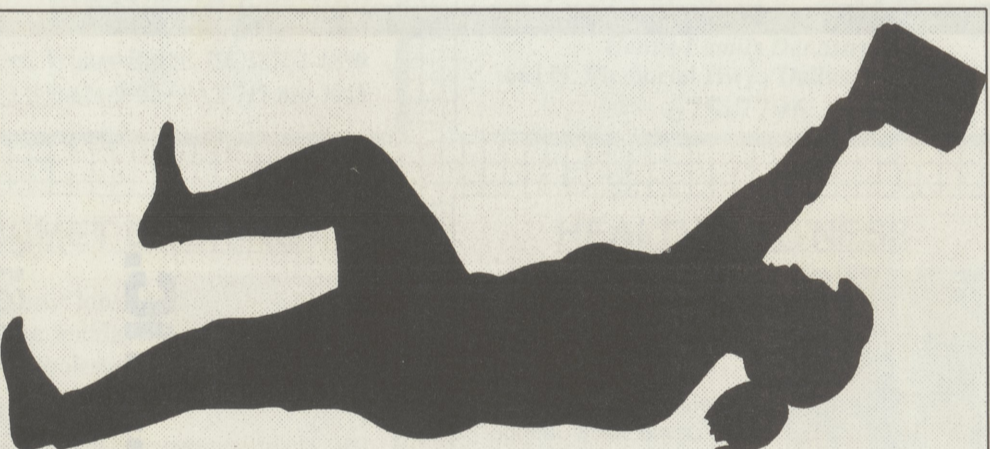
