## New members appointed to water, recreation panels

**KINGSTON TOWNSHIP** - The supervisors unanimously appointed Leonard Reggie to the water commission and Robin Geisinger and Jeff Miller as alternates at their regular October 11 meeting.

Reggie, 49, lives on Firecut Road and is a self-employed cabinet maker. He said he has a strong interest in conservation.

Unanimously appointed recreation commission members were Robert Zaruta and Kristen Gladey, and alternate Edward Brewer.

The supervisors also unanimously approved a resolution to reimburse the township for any expenditures on architectural plans and engineering studies form the sale of municipal bonds to fund the proposed new township building. To date the town-

ship has spent approximately \$10,000 on studies and plans, according to township manager Jeff Box.

No timeline has been set yet for construction, if the supervisors decide to build the building, Box said.

In planning and zoning matters, the supervisors unanimously approved the rezoning of the 22-acre Lembe property on Harris Hill Road from conservation to agricultural, the Novicki minor subdivision on Firecut Road and the Isaacs minor subdivision, which consolidates 14 separate adjoining parcels of land on Route 309 into one deed.

The supervisors also approved a cost of living increase for eligible retired policemen, with retired police chief Paul Sabol abstaining.

The annual society Christmas dinner to be held at the Knights of Columbus Hall, December 3, will be chaired by Ann Domnick.

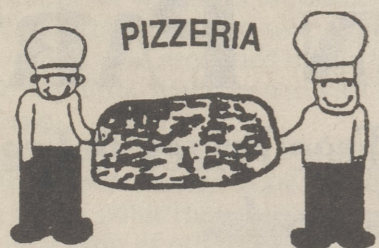
The society does volunteer work for Meals on Wheels, is responsible for keeping the altar linens clean and presentable every year,
