## Dallas police chief runs down man with knife

A knife-wielding shoplifting suspect led cops on a not-so-merry chase through back yards, but in the end they got their man.

According to Dallas Borough police, David Robert Haas, 34, of Tunkhannock was arrested December 5 and charged with aggravated assault, making terroristic threats, possession of a concealed weapon and retail theft.

Police said Haas set off a store alarm when he tried to steal a Lady Remington shaver valued at

\$24.99 from the Rite-Aid Pharmacy in the Dallas Village Shopping Center shortly after 11:30 a.m. Pulling the box from the front of his pants, he handed it to manager Joseph Gavenonis and bolted out the front door, Gavenonis hot on his heels.

Rounding the back of the building, Haas pulled out a daggertype knife and told Gavenonis to "back off." Haas then ran off in the vicinity of Wellington Street.

Police chief Jack Fowler fol-

lowed Haas on foot through the neighborhood after Gavenonis flagged him down as he pulled into the store's parking lot and gave him a description of the thief.

In an attempt to disguise himself, Haas removed his hat and coat and threw them into a smoldering burning barrel as he ran through a back yard between Wellington Street and Route 309, where Fowler arrested him.

Haas is free on bail.
