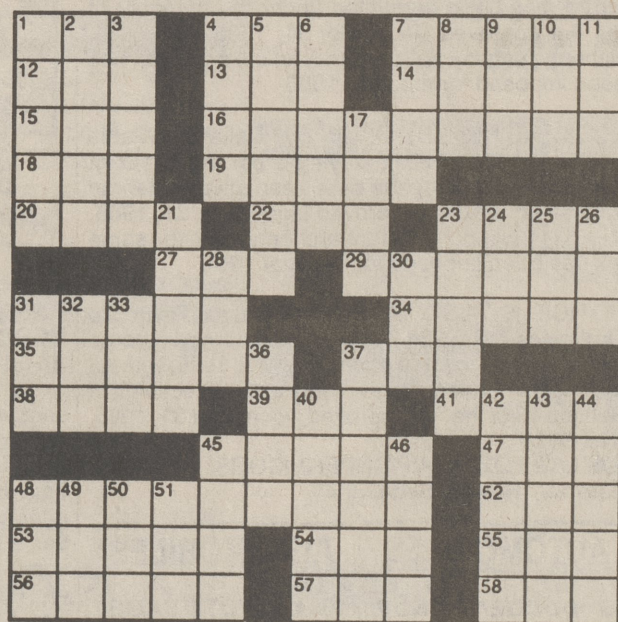
Doctor seeks used eyeglass frames
