

Dallas cheerleaders will perform at Disney World

The Dallas High School cheerleaders have qualified, by their performance at the Pocono Mountain Regional, for the U.C.A. National High School Cheerleading Championship, to be held at Disney - MGM Studios, Orlando, Florida.

The competition will be held, Feb. 8-13. This is the eighth year that a Dallas High School cheerleading squad will represent their district at the national event.

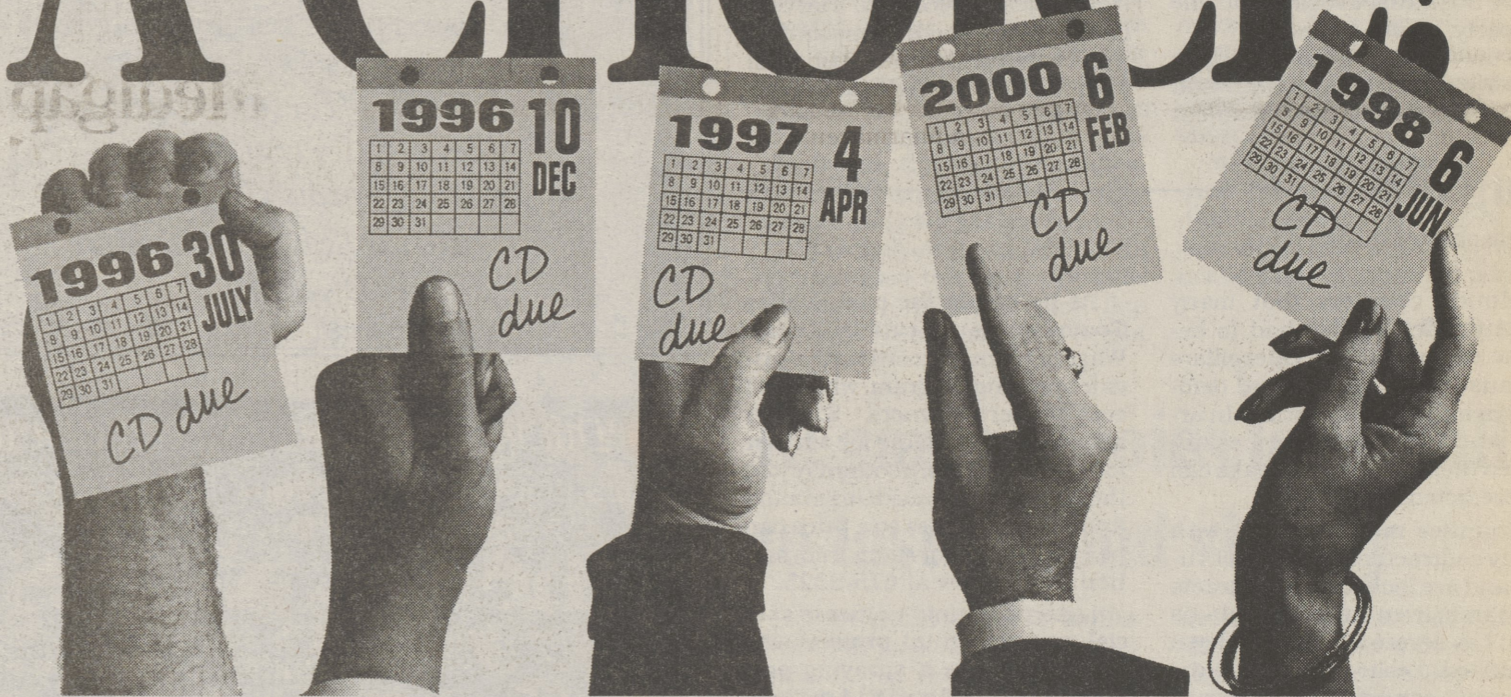
Messersmith of Dallas; and senior Kevin Rogers, son of Mr. and Mrs. Jerome Rogers of Shavertown.

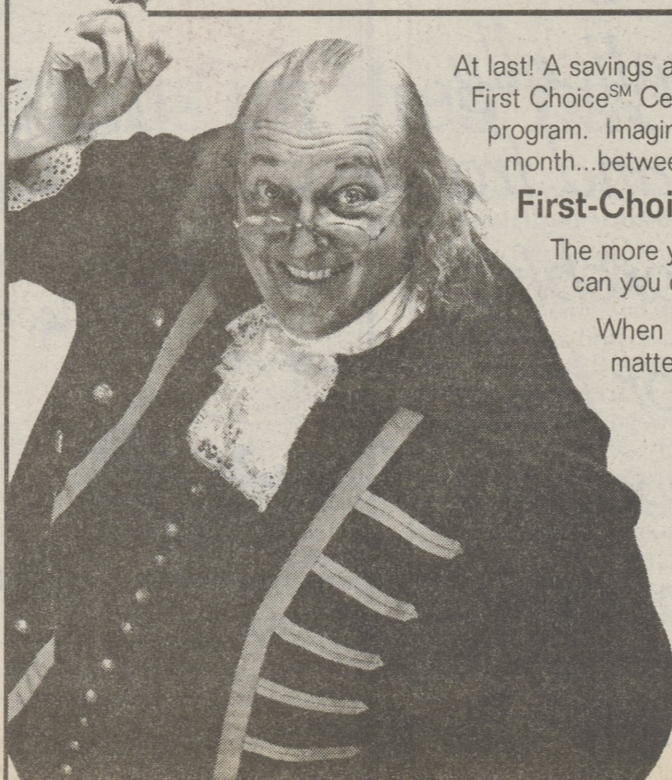
