



Some success with the several varieties of Dwarf Rhododendron (Rhododendron PJM', 'Balta', and 'Olga Mezitt' just to name a few) has been observed. Their resistant qualities can be attributed to their parent age to the native Carolina Rhodo-dendron (Rhododendron carolinianum).

Cryptomeria prefers an open, sunny site to light over-story shade, it has a similar light and feathery texture. The foliage is a beautiful bright blue-green in the summer and turns slightly bronzeeaten. Japanese Cryptomeria (Cryptomeria japonica 'Yoshino') is a great substitution for Canadian Hemlock. While Japanese Japanese Pieris (Pieris japonica) and English Boxwood (Buxus sempervirens) are two staples in green in colder weather


