Three fires ruled arson

FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP - Three fires set within two miles and 35 minutes of one another have been ruled arson, according to Pennsylvania State Police fire marshal Andrew Petros.

"All I can say at this time is the fires were set," he said. "We're still investigating them."

Five minutes after a home owned by Pittston residents Frank and Lucille Fronczek on Green Castle Road in Centermoreland caught fire May 30, six school buses parked behind the Emanuel Bus Lines garage on Village Road in Orange were set ablaze. The

fire, reported at 3:35 a.m., heavily damaged the buses.

Emanuel is the transportation contractor for the Dallas school district.

A third fire was discovered at 3:30 a.m. in a vacant home on Village Road in Orange.

Bus line owner Jeff Emanuel could not be reached for comment.

The holiday weekend isn't a fortunate time for the bus line. In 1993 an early morning fire on Memorial Day destroyed a smaller bus garage which the company also owned and used on Village Road near Municipal Road in Orange.
