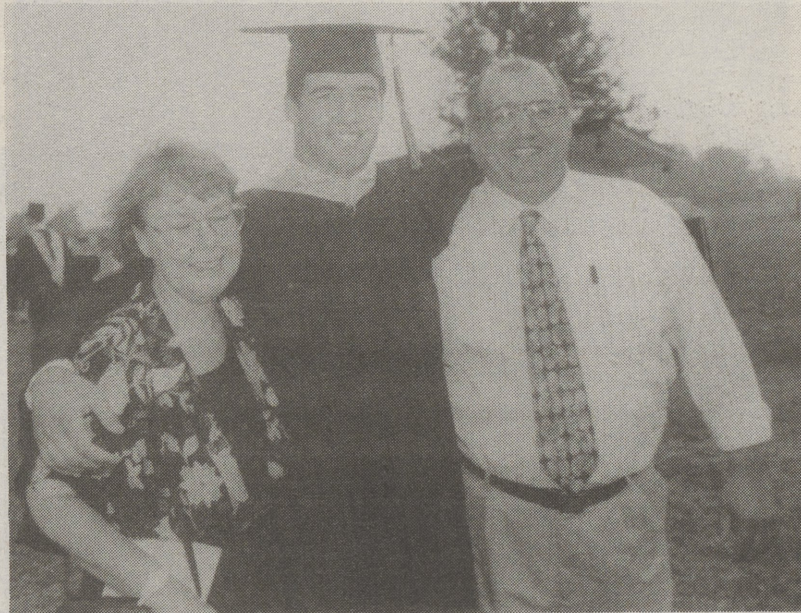
Open House will be held on Sunday, June 23, from 2-5 p.m. at the Eastern Star Building, Foster Street, Dallas.

Jess Winslow, Chase, and Jackie Race, Lehman, from Lake-Lehman's 1995 class, held a balloon for the class of 1996.

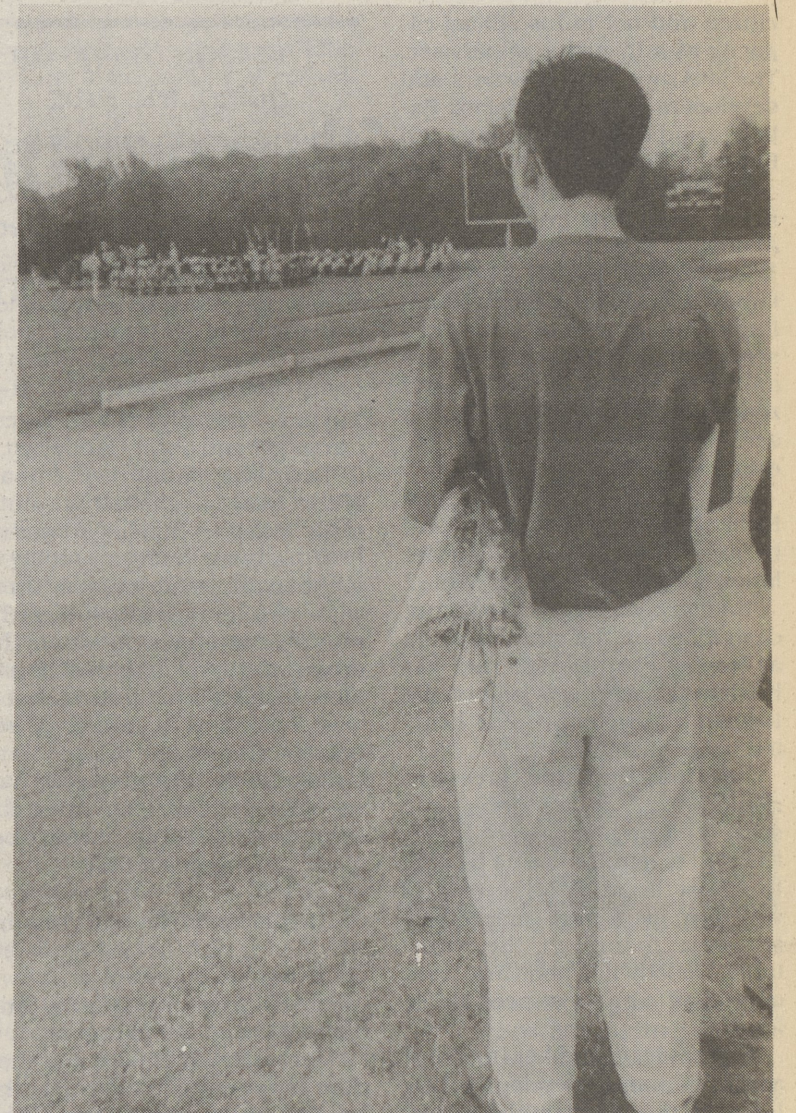


Betsy, Michael and Ed Pitcavage, Chase, proud parents with a graduate.

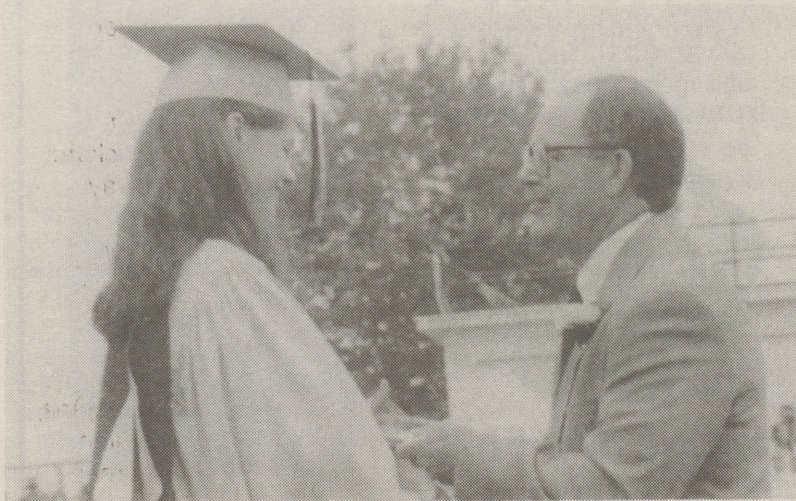
