## Taxes at face value through Nov. 7

Ruth Orloski, Lake Township Tax Collector advises taxpayers that the last day to pay 1996 School Property and Per Capita taxes at Face Value is Nov. 7, 1996, after that date and through Dec. 15 they will be due at Penalty Value. All unpaid County, Municipal and Township Per Capita Taxes are due at Penalty Value.

The last day to pay all 1996 Property and Per Capita taxes is Dec. 15, 1996. After that date all unpaid Property Taxes will be sent to Luzerne County Court House Tax Claim Bureau for collection. An additional filing fee will be added.

Unpaid Township and School Per Capita taxes will be turned over to Berkheimer Assoc. for collection with additional penalties added.
