


Jim Hawk as a sea dog holding Hester Prynne (Lori Robey) captive. He's associated with AAA Travel.


District Justice James Tupper kept everyone guessing about the identity of the old washerwoman until it became too hot under his mask.

Mary Ellen Giannuzzi, Designs by Donnelly, lit up the proceedings with her eyecatching headgear.









