Seniors should watch for financial aid info

Seniors who took S.A.T.s should watch the mail for F.A.F.S.A. (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) form which will be coming in the mail by mid December. This form must be completed in order for any student to qualify for state or federal aid. Students who do not receive this form should contact the Guidance office. Remember, this form is critical!

Parents of seniors...Please plan on attending the Dallas High Financial Aid Night on Wed., Jan. 8, at 7 p.m. at the high school.

Peggy Charnick from College Misericordia will be on hand to explain the procedures for attaining the best financial aid package possible.

Juniors and seniors in the top 10% of their class should see their counselor to see if they qualify for the Wilkes University Young Scholars Program. This program allows high school students to take college courses at the rate of \$15 per credit.

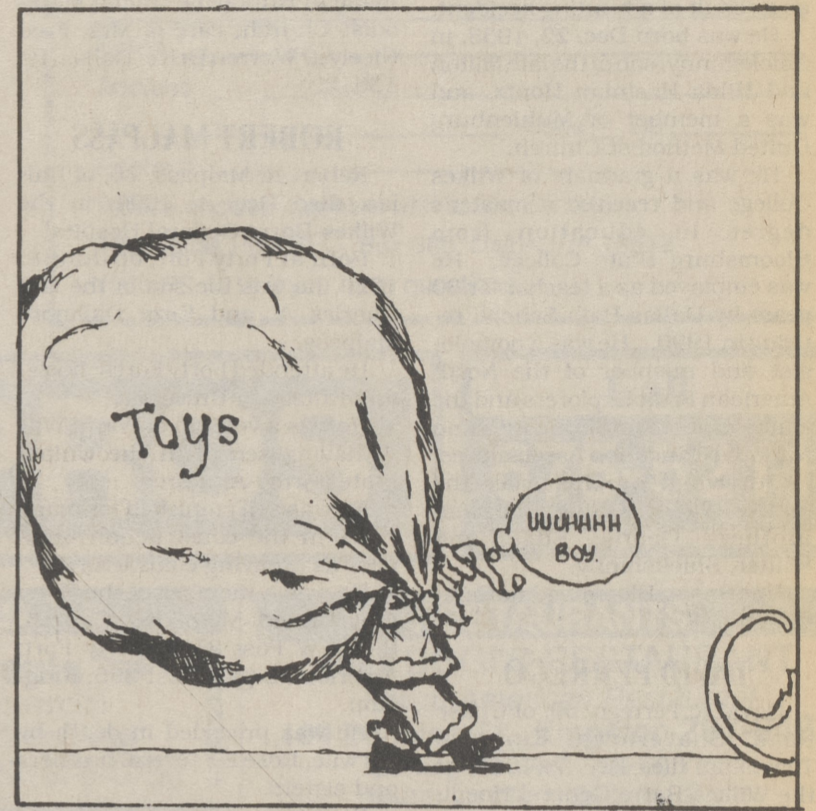
Stop in the Guidance Office for details.

Freshmen and sophomores who took N.E.D.T.s and juniors who took P.S.A.T.s should stop in and receive their test results at their convenience.

Whether it be going for a job or college interview, each of us needs to keep the following in mind. 1) Come alone. 2) Come a little early. 3) Address the interviewer by title and name. 4) Shake hands firmly. 5) Wait until you are asked to be seated. 6) Maintain good eye contact. 7) Take time to think about your answers and don't be afraid to ask for clarification if you don't understand the question. 8) **Be Positive.** Stress your qualifications. 9) Ask when you may call to learn about the interviewer's decision.
