NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY FOR HILL-BURTON UNCOMPENSATED CHARITY CARE SERVICE

Community Medical Center is required by law to give a reasonable amount of its services without charge to people unable to pay for medically necessary services. All services of Community Medical Center will be available under the Hill-Burton Program.

Eligibility for free care will be limited to people whose family income is not more than double the current poverty income guidelines (Category B) as established by the Department of Health and Human Services.
