Mrs. Lashford is a member of the Huntsville United Methodist Church where she holds the office of Vice-President in the United Methodist Women. She is a former president and vice-president in Wyoming Conference UMW; a former member of the Women's Division where she chaired the committees for Racial Justice and Contemporary Mission, which includes development and training for conference officers. She served on the United Methodist Committee on Relief for eight years, four of which she served as president; the General Church Commission on Religion and Race for eight years where she chaired the White Concerns Committee. Mrs. Lashford has the distinction of being the first woman elected as Lay-Leader of Wyoming Conference.

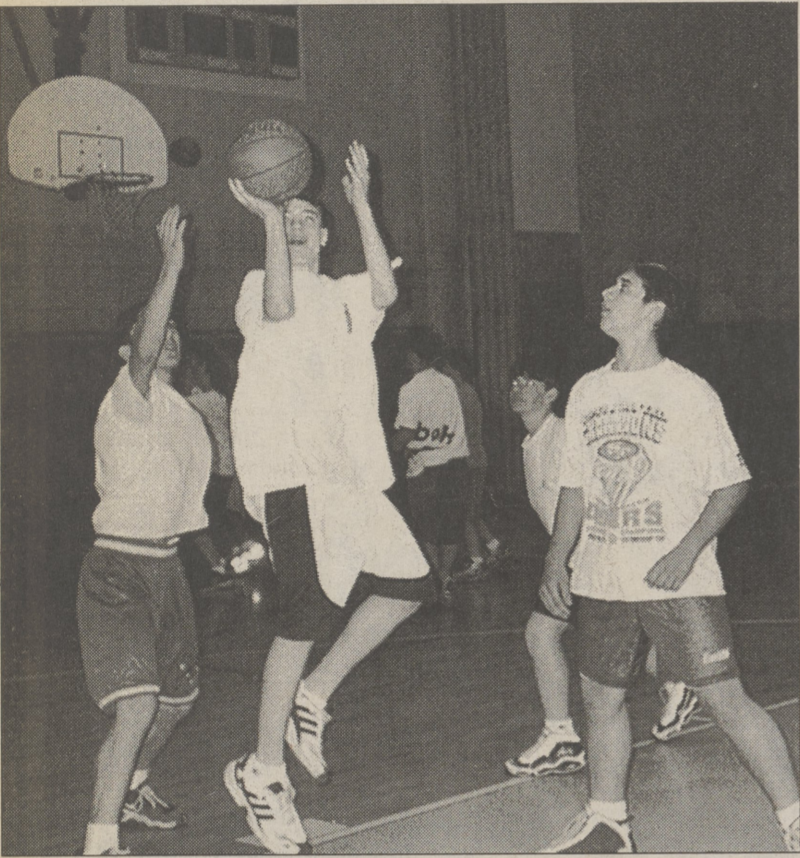

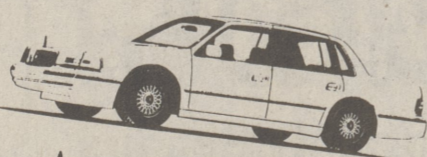

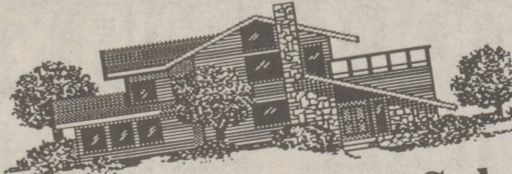
