The fourth annual Hospice Hundred Ride for Dignity is set for Sun. July 27, at the Dallas High School, Dallas. The bicycle ride offers a 100K, 50K and 20K course. The ride has full support of ham radio operators, sag wagons and aid stations.

Proceeds from the Hospice Hundred benefit Hospice Saint John, a Lutheran Welfare Service of Northeastern Pennsylvania. Hospice Saint John cares for over 120 patients and their families every day.

Safe Boating Awareness Day at Harveys Lake June 8

The Northeast Highway Safety Program, in conjunction with the PA Fish & Boat Commission and the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary, will be holding its 7th annual Safe Boating Awareness Day at Harveys Lake public boat launch on Sun., June 8, 1 p.m.-4 p.m. (Rain date, Sun., June 29).

The event is open to the public and free of charge. Information will be offered on topics such as boating, DUI/BUI, oc-

Dr. David Bradbury, assistant professor of communication at Wilkes University, is one of eight media educators in the nation to receive a 1997 summer faculty development grant from the national Association of Television Program Executives.
