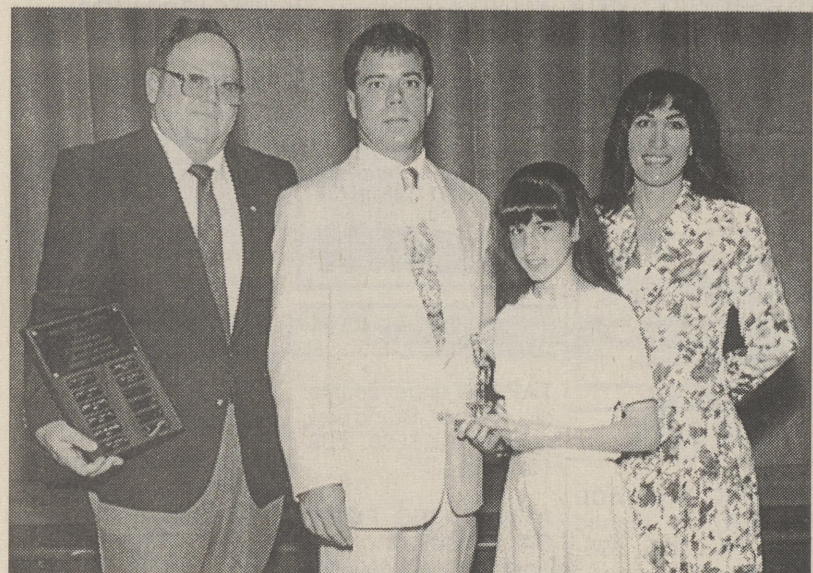

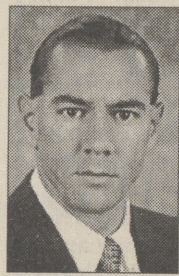
Dickinson law school graduates

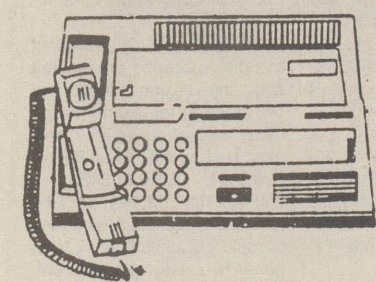
