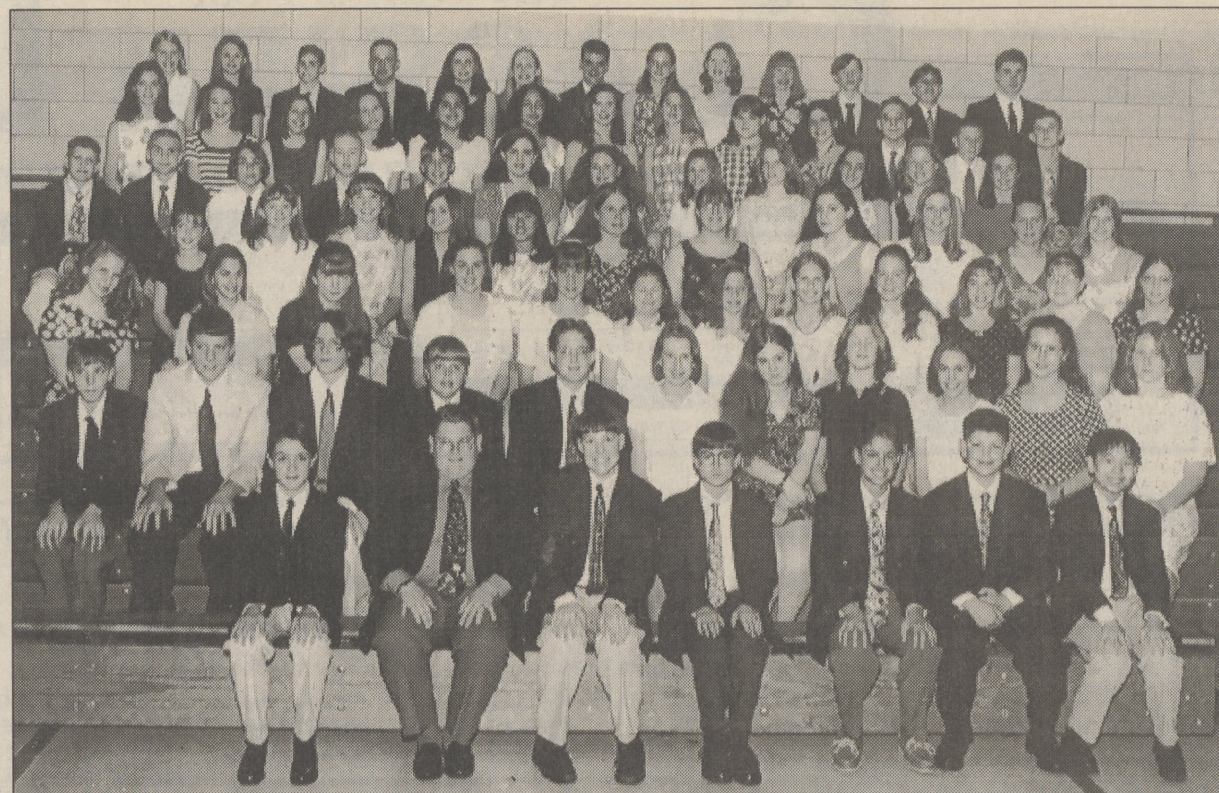


Dallas Nat'l Junior Honor Society
